The 40th Street Bike Path is an asphalt sidepath trail that follows its namesake roadway through a lightly developed stretch of southern



The 40th Street Bike Path is an asphalt sidepath trail that follows its namesake roadway through a lightly developed stretch of southern Rochester, coasting over rolling hills and the edge of woods to the north for a mile and a half. The eastern end of the path provides a way over the highway for cyclists and pedestrians, and also offers a connection to the <u>St. Bridgets Bike Path</u>, a similar trail that offers access to the hotels and businesses by the highway exit. Requiring relatively few road crossings for a sidepath trail, the 40th Street Bike Path is a nice outdoor recreation option if you find yourself in the area.
