The trail allows residents in the neighborhoods around 50th Street to connect to the <u>Line Creek Trail</u> on foot or by bike. The two trails meet at the trailhead in Renner Brenner Park. The Line Creek Trail continues north through Kansas City for a total of 8 miles.
