## **Parking & Trail Access**

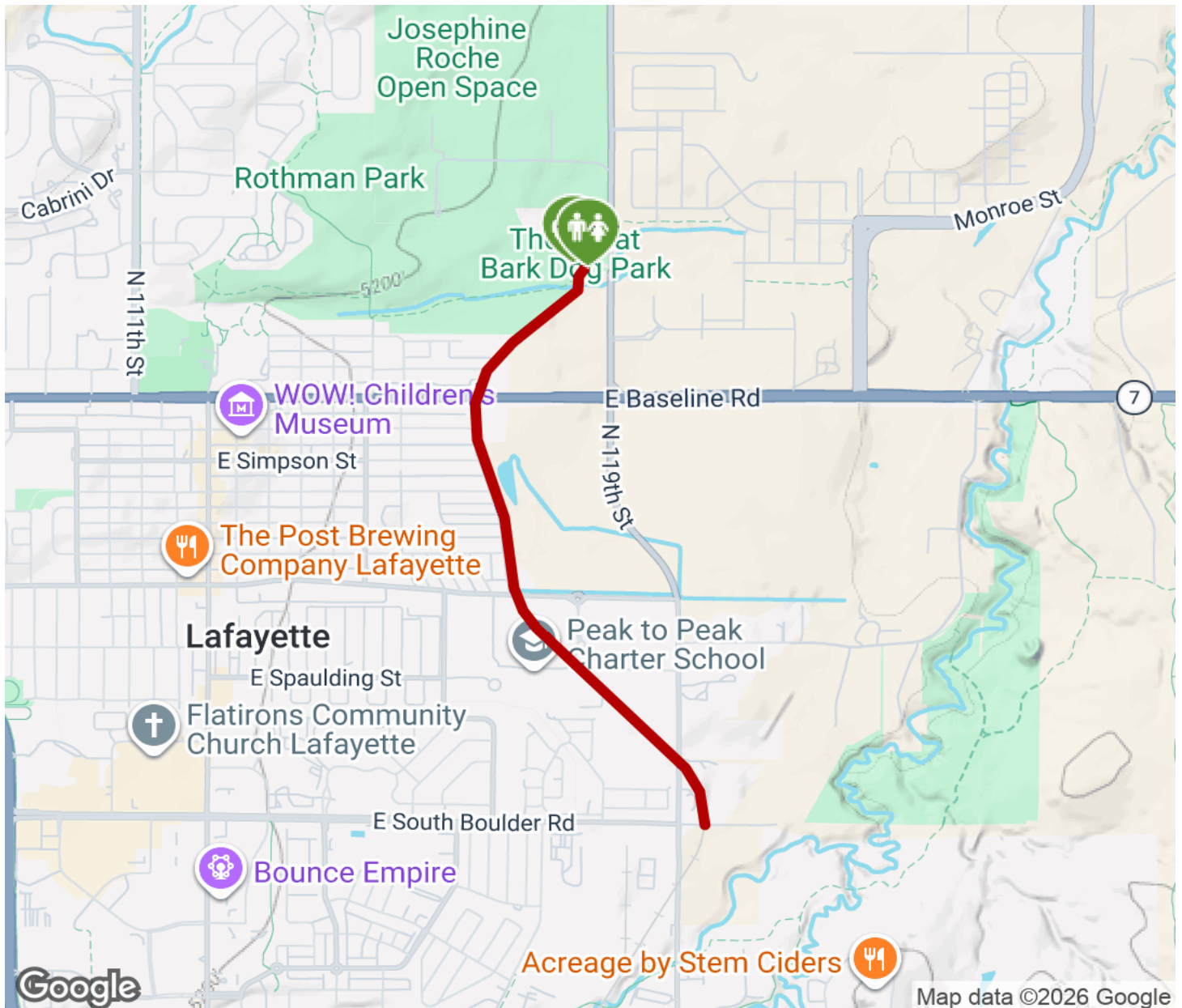
