Ninety Six Town Trail South Carolina



The Ninety Six Town Trail parallels State Route 34 east to west across the length of the town. The trail sits on a disused Norfolk



The Ninety Six Town Trail parallels State Route 34 east to west across the length of the town. The trail sits on a disused Norfolk Southern railway corridor. The trail surface is stone dust except for the stretch that passes through the town's business district, which is paved with concrete and lined with bright crepe myrtle trees. Along this stretch is the Visitor Center, as well as the historic Southern Railway Depot, a redbrick one-story building that is currently a senior center and events space.
