Providing a useful link between the Polk County communities of Monmouth and Rickreall, the Highway 99W Bike Path offers over five miles of paved trail for cyclists and pedestrians. Useful both as a commuting route and as a recreational pathway, the trail offers surprisingly pleasant scenery considering the proximity of the highway. Rolling fields of grasses and farmland border the trail on either side, offering beautiful vistas of the Oregon sky - and very little shade, so be prepared for some sun exposure.

No dedicated parking is provided for this trail, but parking may be available on-street or at local businesses near the trail. Be sure to follow any posted parking signs and regulations.



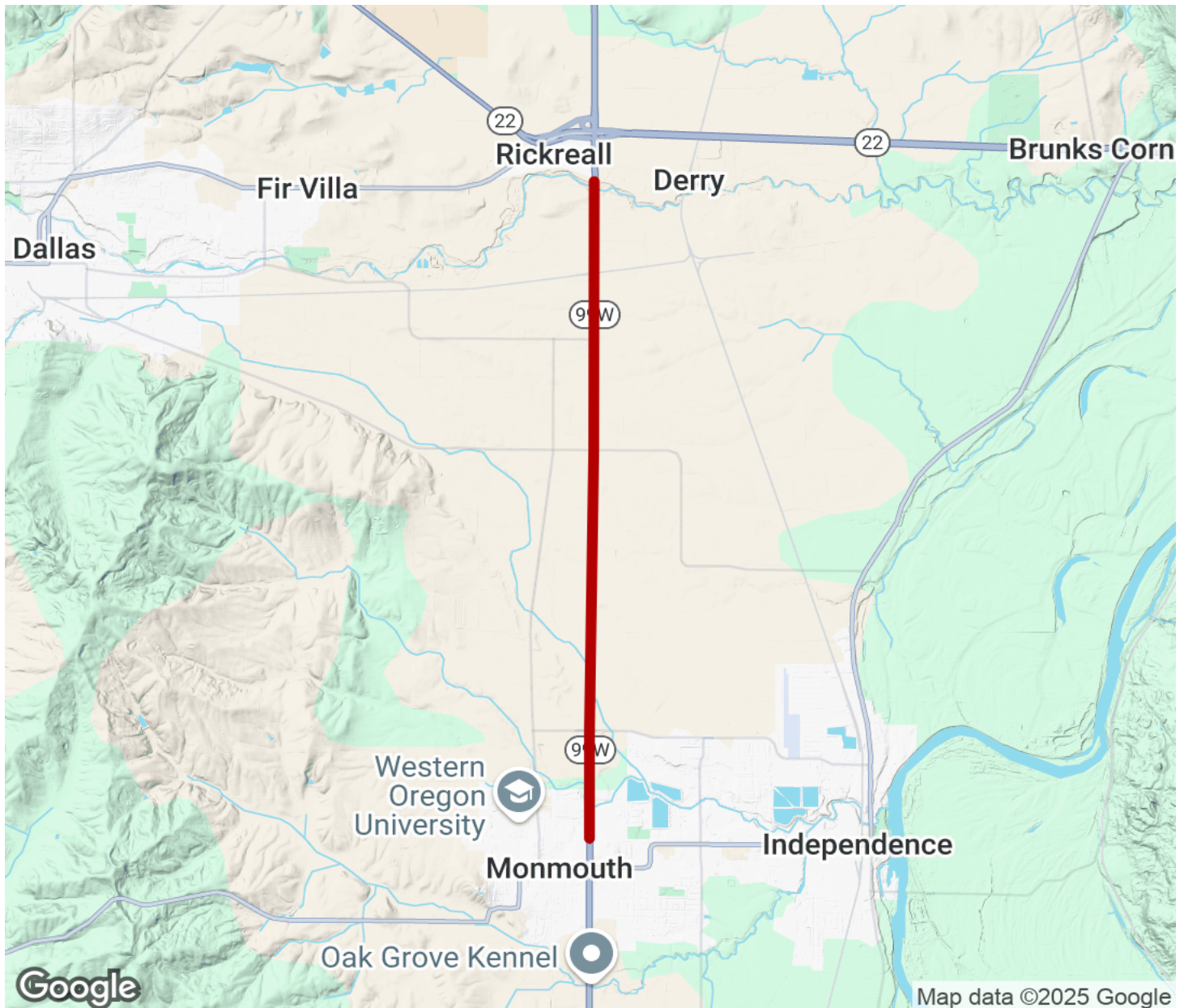
