Walnut Boulevard/ 53rd St. Multi- Use Path

Oregon



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A paved asphalt sidepath that runs along the western side of 53rd Street and Walnut Boulevard, this trail may not be much to look at, but it offers important connections to a whole host of trails and parks on the west side of Corvallis.

Beginning in the south at a junction with the [Corvallis-Philomath Multi-Modal Path](#), the trail heads north along 53rd Street, passing by the county fairgrounds at another trail junction with the [Midge Cramer Multi-Use Path](#). The trail leaves civilization behind (aside from the adjacent roadway) as it continues north along Walnut Boulevard, coming to an end after passing through the city's Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Park.

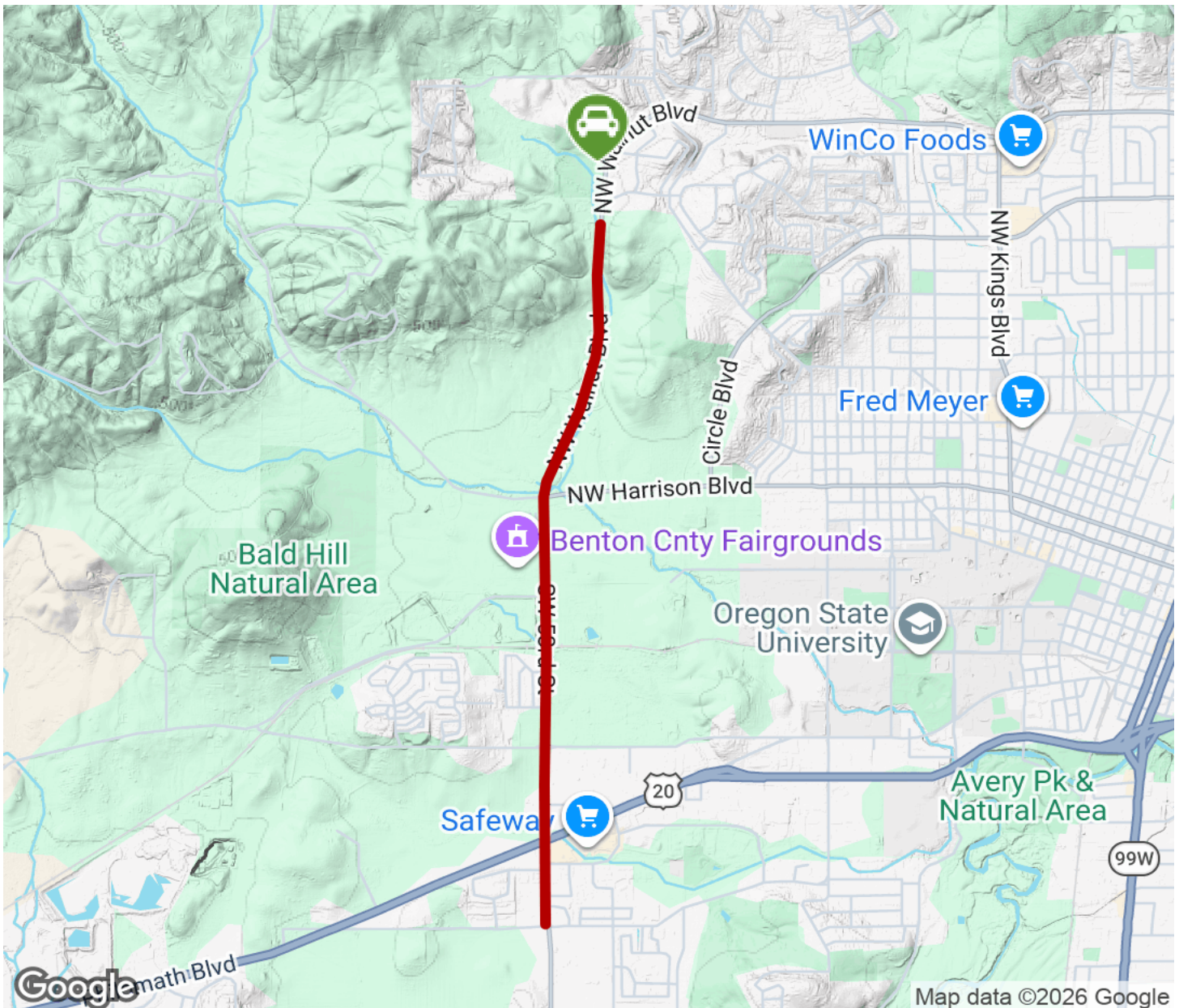
Parking & Trail Access
