This north-south bikeway in southeast Chico is dedicated to the memory of local resident and avid cyclist and cycling advocate,



This north-south bikeway in southeast Chico is dedicated to the memory of local resident and avid cyclist and cycling advocate, Steve Harrison. The trail entrances at both ends are marked by distinctive sprocket arches. At the south end, the trail parallels Skyway Road until the Honey Run Road intersection, providing an out-and-back distance of just over 2 miles. The trail is asphalt and easy enough for users of all ages. There is no tree cover so keep that in mind when going out. The trail is located in a developing area, the site of an upcoming subdivision.

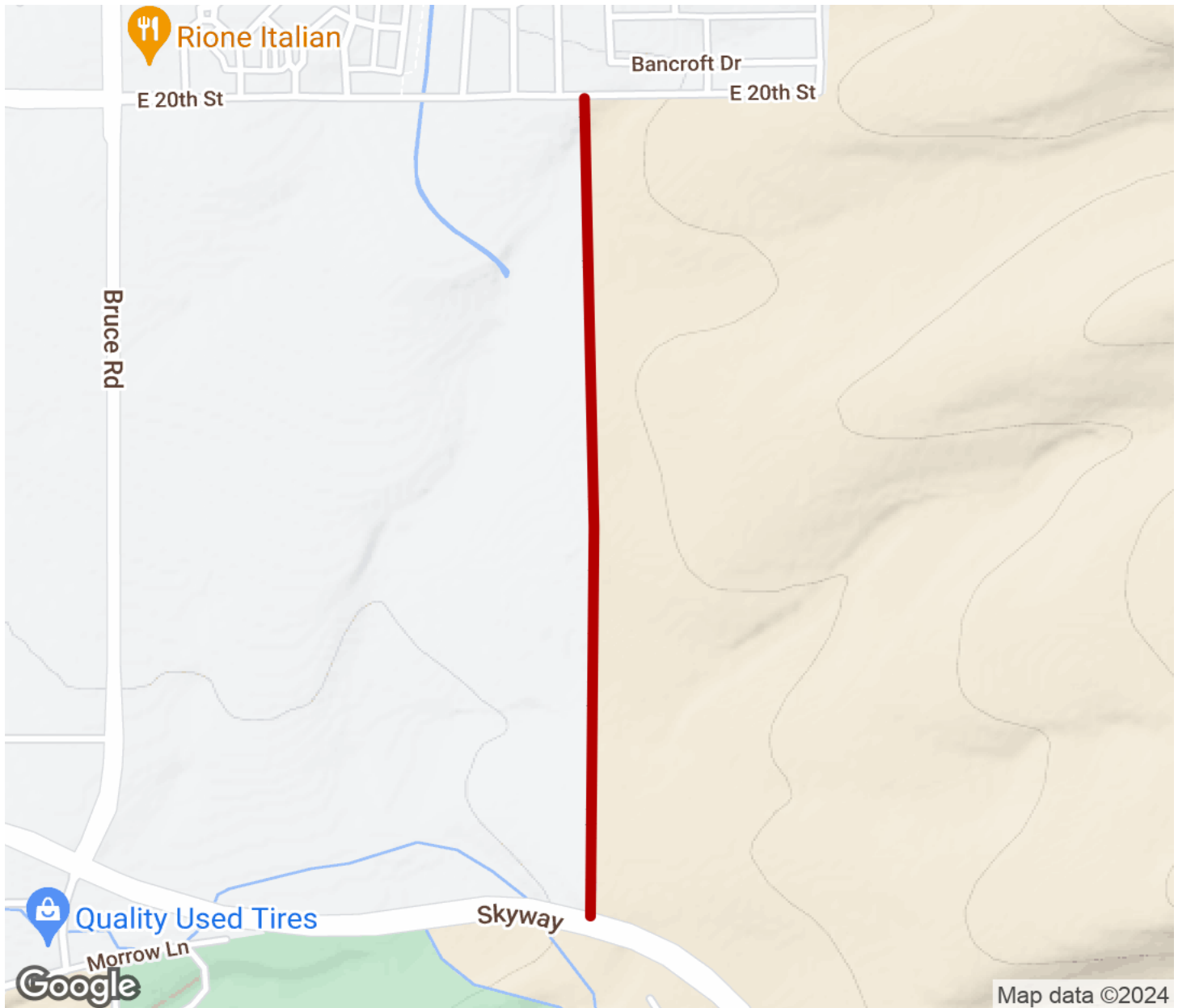
Parking & Trail Access
