This paved walking and biking pathway sits on the western edge of the village of Virginia Gardens village as well as Miami Springs.



This paved walking and biking pathway sits on the western edge of the village of Virginia Gardens village as well as Miami Springs. The trail occupies the grassy margin of Ludlam Drive (NW 67th Avenue). The trail is also adjacent to a canal, on the other side of which is the wall of a railyard. Trees and bushes line the trail but the canal generally remains visible in spite of the foliage. There are benches, trash receptacles and dog waste stations provided. In addition, there are also tiki huts with picnic tables facing the water. Following reports of an alligator sighting in the canal, the village added signs warning trail users that there is a chance of encountering their scaly neighbors.

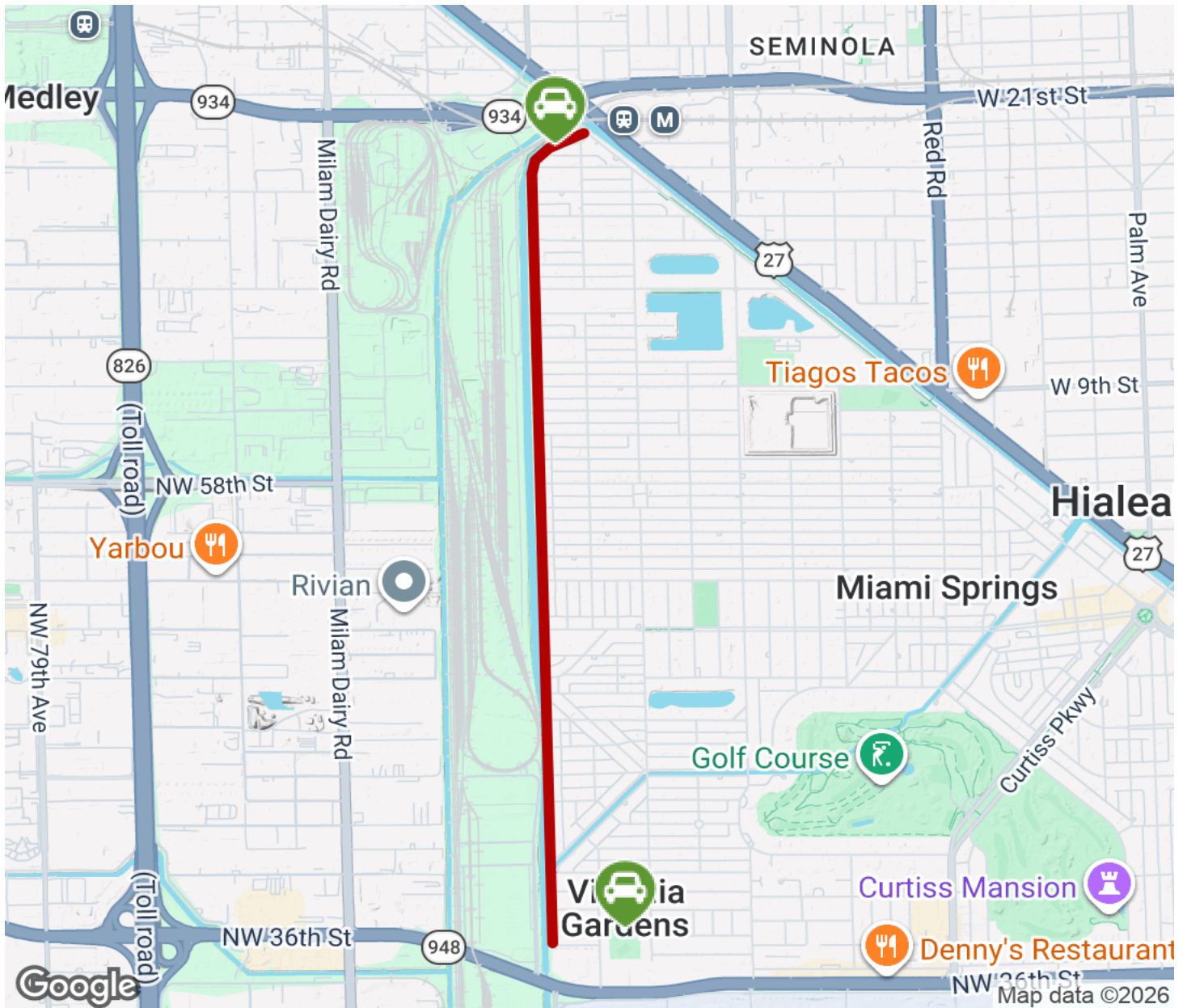
Parking & Trail Access
