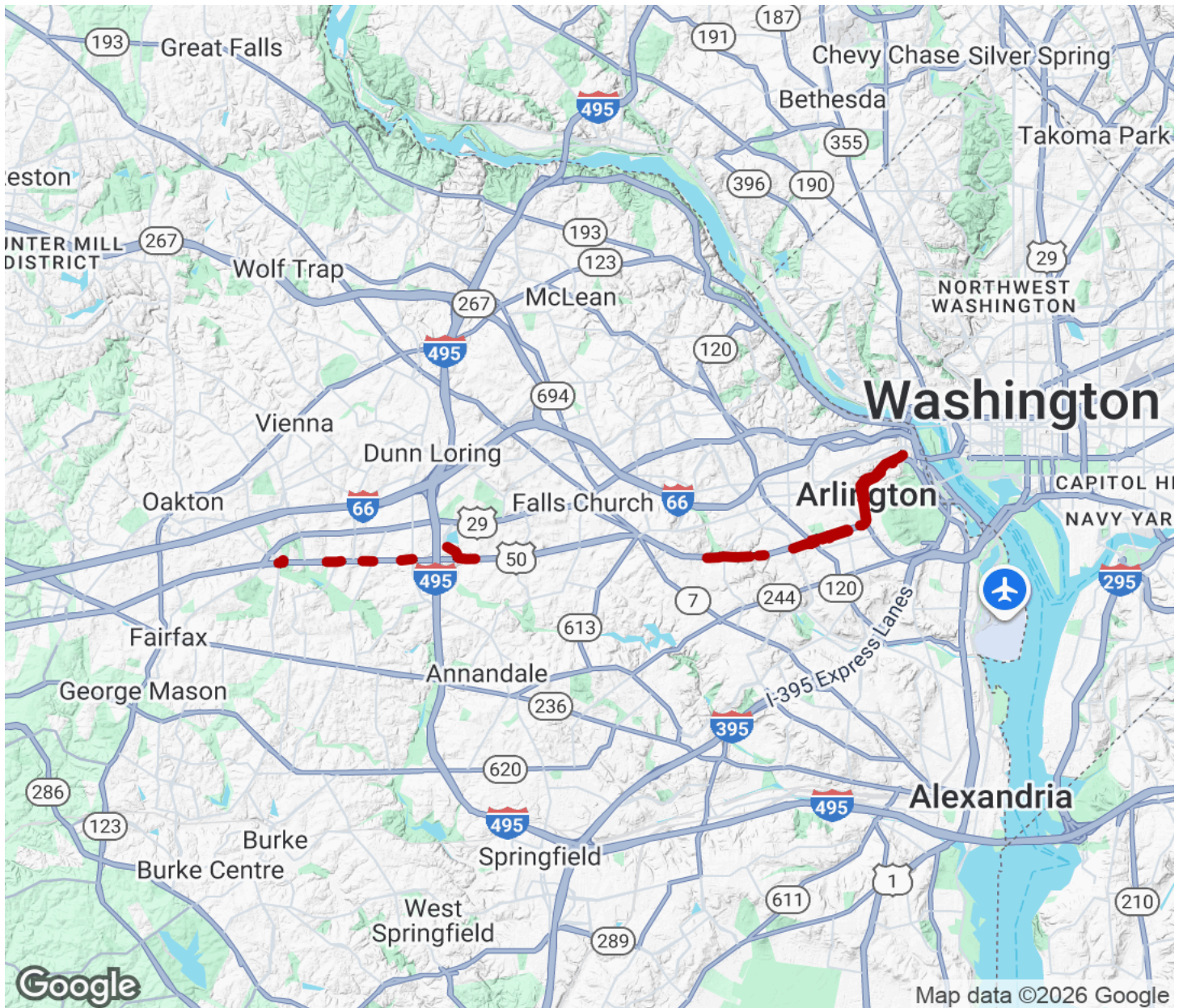
The Arlington Boulevard Trail runs between N Ft. Meyer Dr. (Arlington) and N George Mason Dr. (Arlington).
