Trail users can always count on the Meadowmont Trail for a pleasant, scenic amble that takes you up grassy hills, through leafy woodlands and across stately neighborhoods with pretty gardens. The trail is a milelong north-south pathway, stretching between Rashkis Elementary and Raleigh Road/ State Route 54 near the Chapel Hill/ Durham county border. There are some street crossings (at Barbee Chapel Road, Sprunt Street and Simerville Road) but the trail remains well-marked and easy to follow. At the south end, it intersects with the which has its own smooth, two-lane multiuse trail occupying both the north and south side of Raleigh Road.
