The trail runs just short of a mile east from the trailhead on Mailer Boulevard. It sits in the green swath dedicated to transmission towers and overhead power lines. The trail is flat asphalt, an easy walk or ride for most users. There are concrete sidewalks leading from different parts of the subdivision to the trail for easy access.

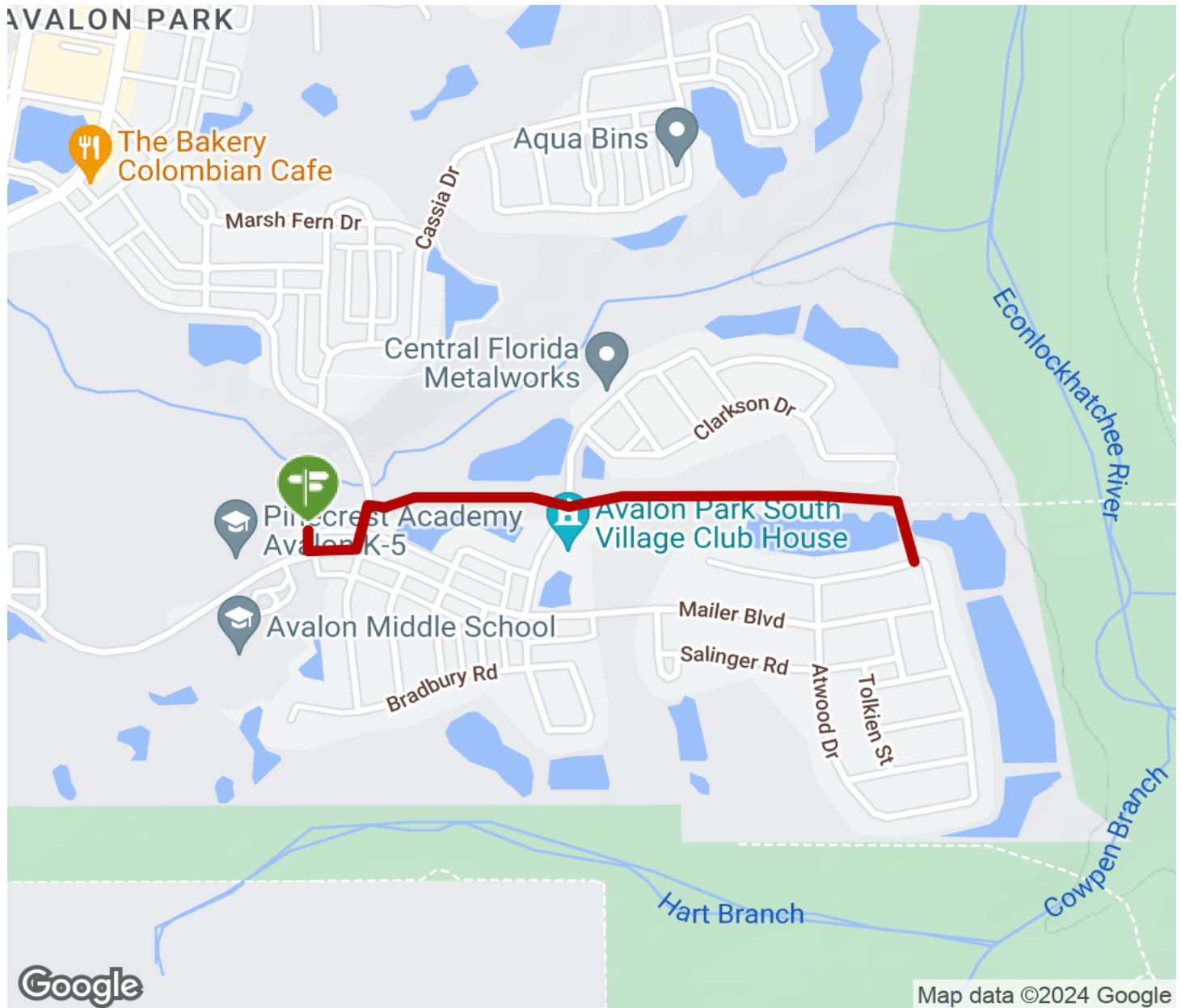
## Parking & Trail Access
