The Brevard Zoo Linear Park is a mixed-surface trail running along the wetlands on the east side of I-95 near Brevard Zoo. The 3-



The Brevard Zoo Linear Park is a mixed-surface trail running along the wetlands on the east side of I-95 near Brevard Zoo. The 3-mile journey (6 miles round trip) takes users from the zoo through wetlands and islands of pine and oak, underneath Pineda Causeway and to the Turtle Mound cul-de-sac. The boardwalks provide a great vantage point to observe the wetland's resident flora and fauna and colorful signage highlights the area's natural and cultural heritage.

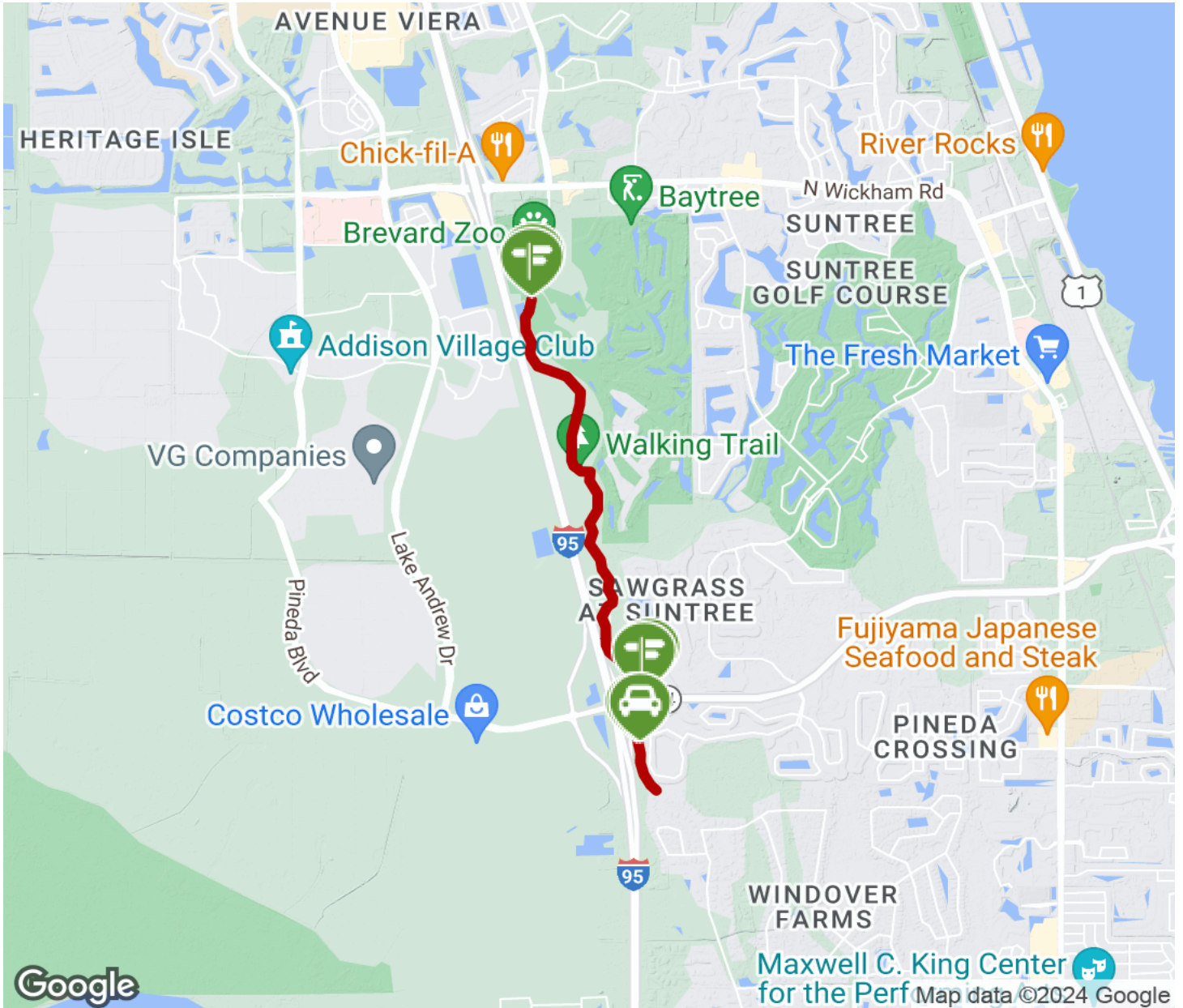
Parking & Trail Access
