The trail starts on Country Road 100 and takes a straight route north either through or adjacent to residential subdivisions. From CR 200 north, the trail is sandwiched between single-family homes on one side and corn fields on the other.

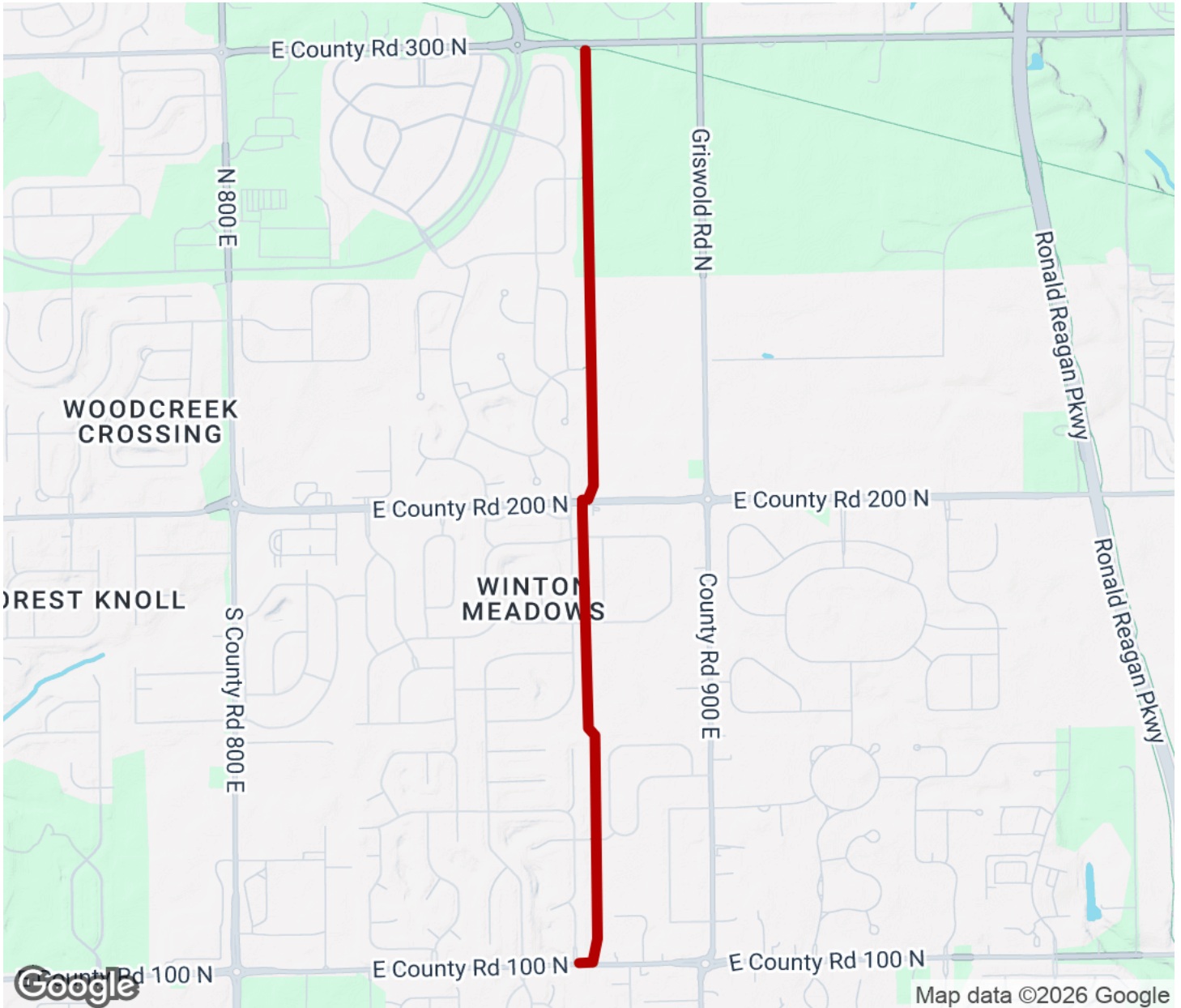
Parking & Trail Access
