The Euchee Creek Greenway is a developing bike and pedestrian project in Columbia County, Georgia. At present, the trail is open in two sections, with the southern segment consisting of an approximately twomile section in Grovetown. The wide paved trail snakes through the verdant woods around Euchee Creek between Wrightsboro Road and Harlem Grovetown Road. Benches and picnic tables are provided at intervals along the trail.

A separate section is complete to the north, stretching over five miles from the Canterbury Farms subdivision north to Patriots Park. The part of this trail along Columbia Road features slopes that might be challenging for some users. Future plans call for extending the trail further north and east to provide an off-road connection all the way to Savannah Rapids Park, via the existing <u>Evans to Locks Multi-Use Trail</u>.

Parking & Trail Access


For the Grovetown segment, parking is available at either end of the trail: The north trailhead is located along Wrightsboro Road while the south trailhead is located at Harlem Grovetown Road.

For the Patriots Park segment, parking can be found in Patriots Park at 5445 Columbia Road.
