Veterans Memorial Trail (IN) Indiana



When complete, the Veterans Memorial Trail will stretch close to 12 miles, connecting a series of memorials honoring US veterans



When complete, the Veterans Memorial Trail will stretch close to 12 miles, connecting a series of memorials honoring US veterans from every era. At present, 1.9 miles are complete and usable, located at either end of the future trail: 0.9 miles have been built in Crown Point, Indiana, which is also the south endpoint of the <u>Erie</u> <u>Lackawanna Trail</u>. In summer of 2020, the town of Hebron celebrated the opening of it's first mile, which parallels US 231 up to the Porter-Lake county line. At about the midpoint of this segment is the future site of a Middle East veterans memorial.

The Veterans Memorial Trail is part of the <u>Great</u> <u>American Rail Trail</u> route through Indiana.

Parking & Trail Access


The Erie Lackawanna Trailhead is located on Summit Street only 500 ft west of the start of the Crown Point segment.
