## Veterans Memorial Trail (IN)

*When complete, the Veterans Memorial Trail will stretch close to 12 miles, connecting a series of memorials honoring US veterans*



When complete, the Veterans Memorial Trail will stretch close to 12 miles, connecting a series of memorials honoring US veterans from every era. At present, 1.9 miles are complete and usable, located at either end of the future trail: 1.5 miles have been built in Crown Point, Indiana, which is also the south endpoint of the [Erie Lackawanna Trail](#). In summer of 2020, the town of Hebron celebrated the opening of its first mile, which parallels US 231 up to the Porter-Lake county line. At about the midpoint of this segment is the future site of a Middle East veterans memorial.

The Veterans Memorial Trail is part of the [Great American Rail Trail](#)'s route through Indiana.

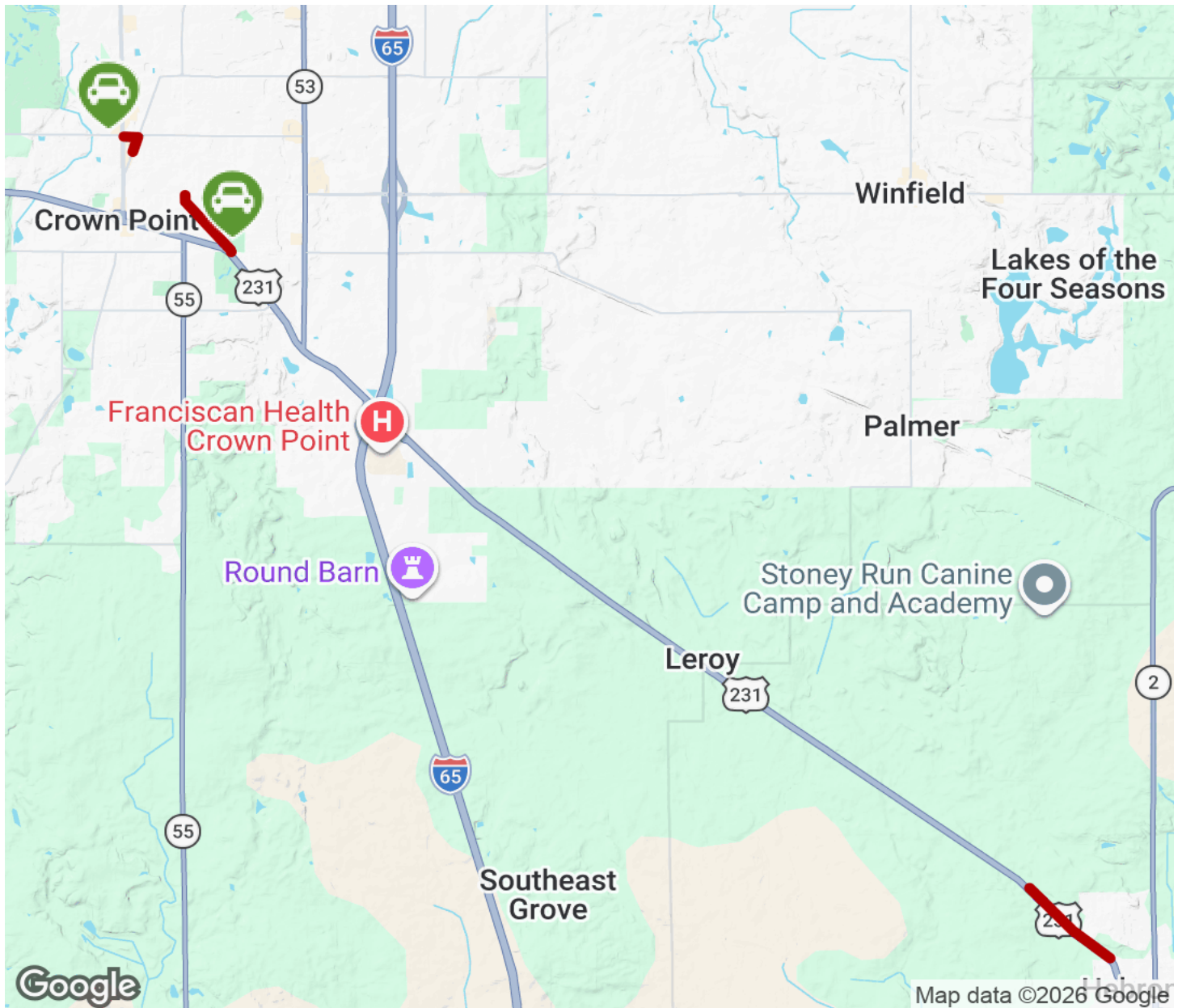
Parking for the Veteran's Memorial Trail is available off of Summit Street.
