The Dresden Green Rail Trail sits on a converted railbed cutting through the center of Dresden, in northwest Tennessee. The trail



The Dresden Green Rail Trail sits on a converted railbed cutting through the center of Dresden, in northwest Tennessee. The trail starts just east of the site of an old railroad bridge that went over Pikeview Street. It then extends eastward through some woods. It threads through several destinations as it winds from west to east including the town cemetery, Terry Oliver Plaza, with its pavillion that hosts Dresden's Farmers Market, and the Harmon & Lucille McWherter Civic Center.

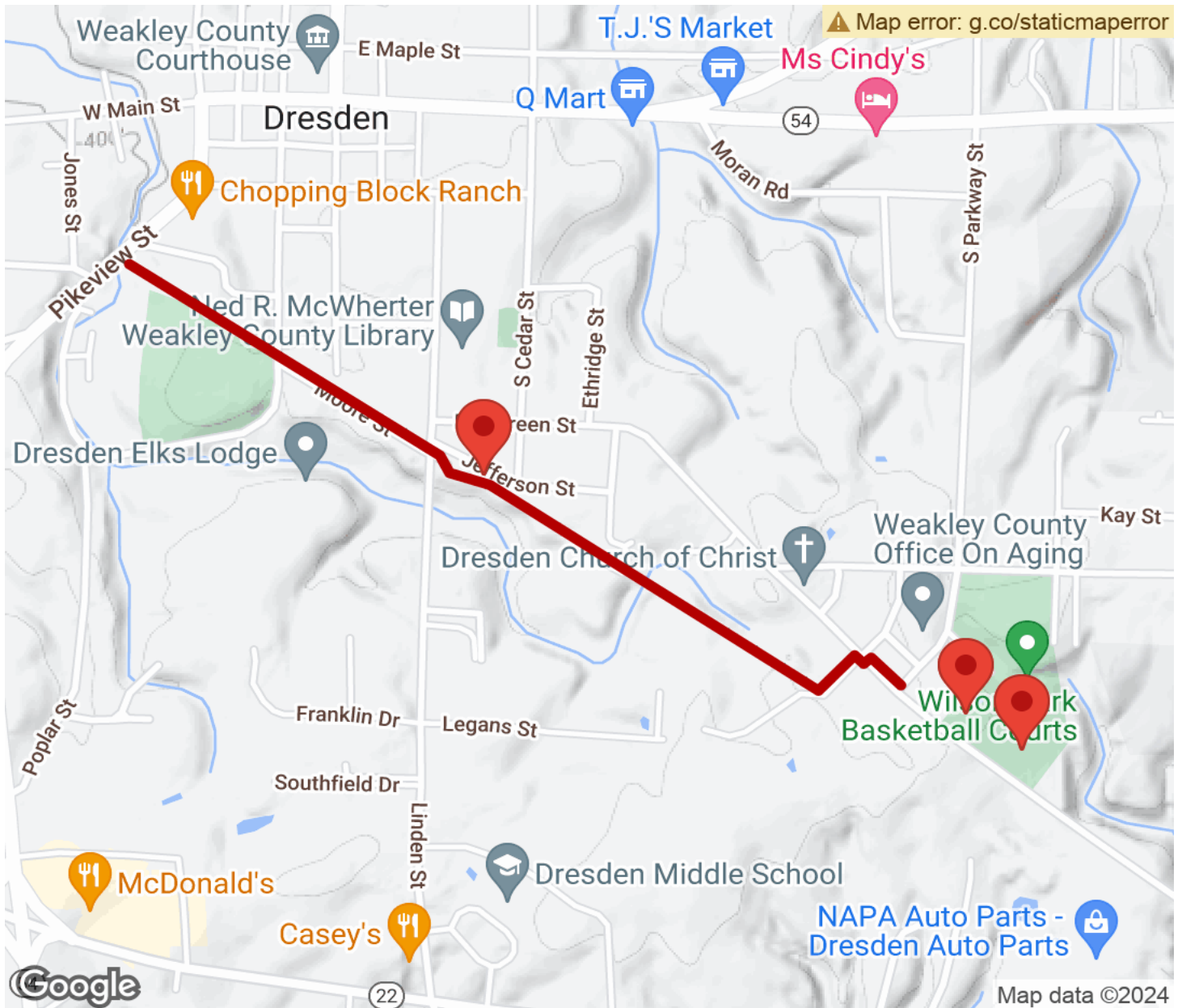
Parking & Trail Access
