Signal Ditch Trail *Colorado*



Signal Ditch Trail picks up at the north end of the Farmers' High Line Canal Trail and continues northwest. The hike-and-bike trail



Signal Ditch Trail picks up at the north end of the <u>Farmers'</u> <u>High Line Canal Trail</u> and continues northwest. The hikeand-bike trail meanders along Signal Ditch, an irrigation channel which speaks to Thornton's agricultural roots. Today, the trail is surrounded by neat suburban housing and neighborhood open spaces, which include Lake Village Park, Cherrywood Park, Fallbrook Park and Fallbrook Farm Park. The trail also intersects with <u>Lee</u> <u>Lateral Ditch Trail</u> at York Street, which heads then east.

The Signal Ditch is open for non-motorized uses only.


Parking & Trail Access
