This shared-use path sits on the east side of US-95 from Coeur d'Alene to the Athol on the Kootenai County line. The trail was added as part of a US-95 Highway improvement project. The eight existing miles between Appleway Avenue in Coeur d'Alene and Garwood Road were upgraded, and the remaining miles of trail newly constructed as part of the project. The trail might one day be extended even further north, to Sagle. At nearly 40 miles out-and-back, the trail provides plenty of options for users, from walkers wanting to get their daily steps in close to home, to cyclists looking for a way to fill an afternoon by riding the whole distance. Note that there's a slight downward incline riding south. There are some trees but little shade on the trail.

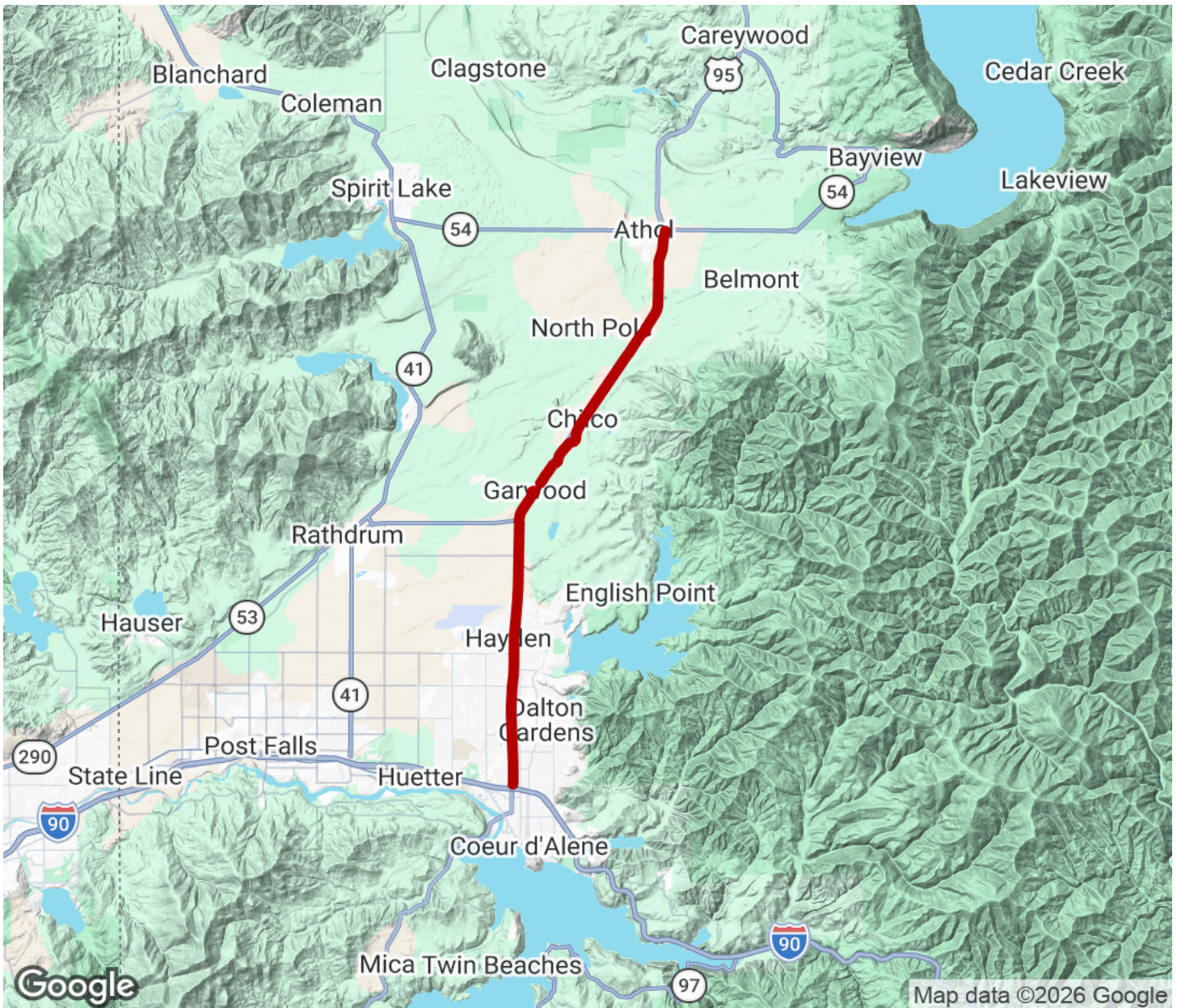
