The Amos Road Trail contributes a mile to Shelbyville's growing trail network. The trail is located in the southern reaches of the city.



The Amos Road Trail contributes a mile to Shelbyville's growing trail network. The trail is located in the southern reaches of the city. It is a flat shared-use path on the side of Amos Road, taking users from the surrounding suburban neighborhoods through cropland to Progress Road, where [another path](#) continues east along the edge of the city. There are plans to extend the trail north, across the railroad tracks, to Broadway Street / SR 44. Another branch will continue through the Twin Lakes neighborhood and connect directly to Progress Road, where that path can in turn lead them to retail and restaurants, as well as to the Blue River Memorial Park and [multi-use trail](#).

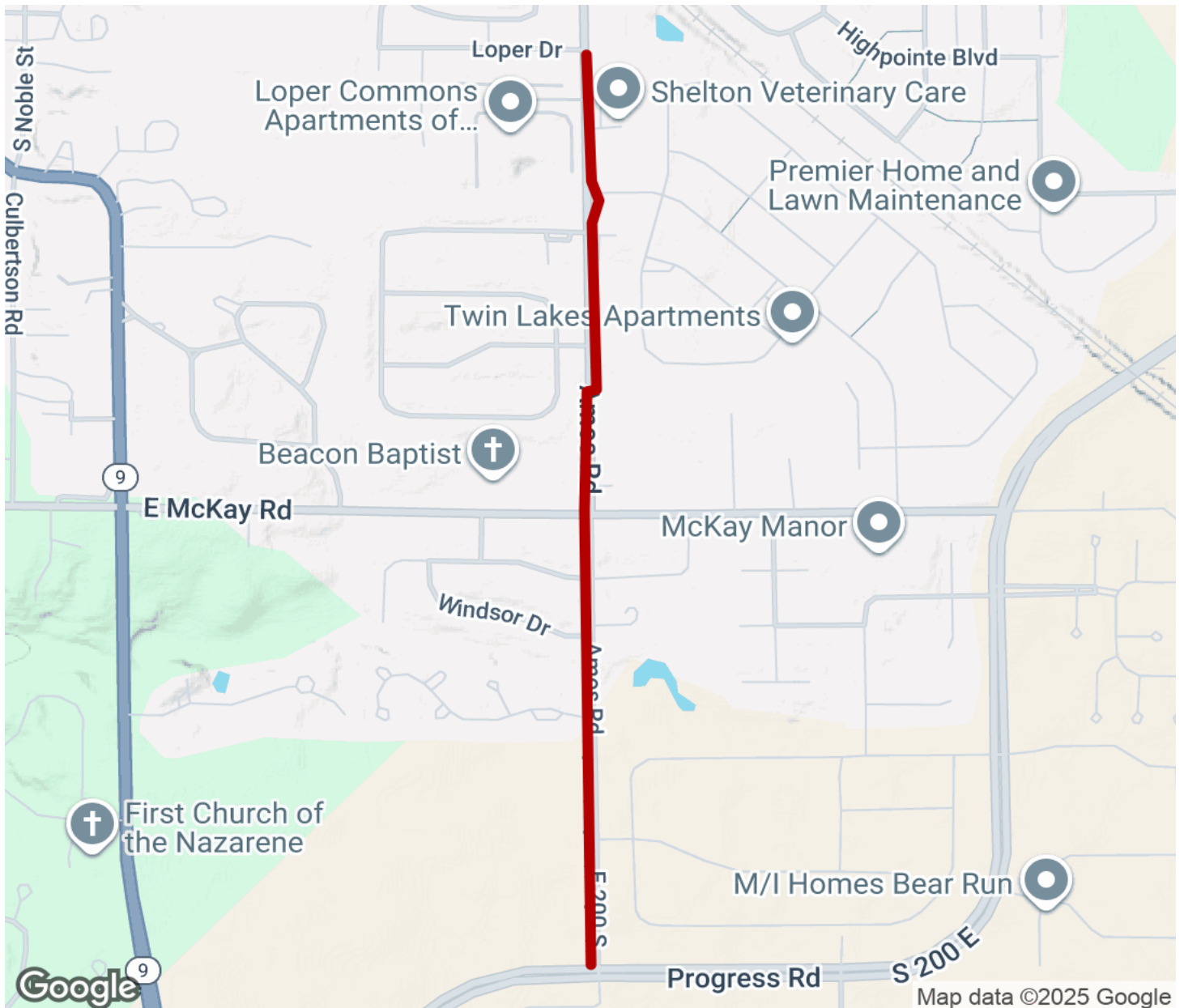
