Progress Parkway Trail

Indiana



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The Progress Parkway Trail is a flat, hardtop shared-use path running along the east edge of Shelbyville, Indiana. Despite its name, the trail actually starts along Lee Boulevard, on the east edge of Blue River Memorial Park, home to the [Blue River Trail](#). Past the park, the sidepath branches onto Progress Parkway at the Walmart Supercenter, the greenery having been replaced by various retail and fast food businesses. After crossing Broadway Street/ SR 44, the trail continues south along Progress Road, with the setting switching commercial to industrial, then to agricultural.

After crossing the railroad, the trail continues south and west, intersecting with [another sidepath](#) at Amos Road, before continuing to its conclusion on SR 9.

Park at the Blue River Memorial Park (725 Lee Blvd.) and then take the walking path back to Lee Boulevard to connect to the trail.



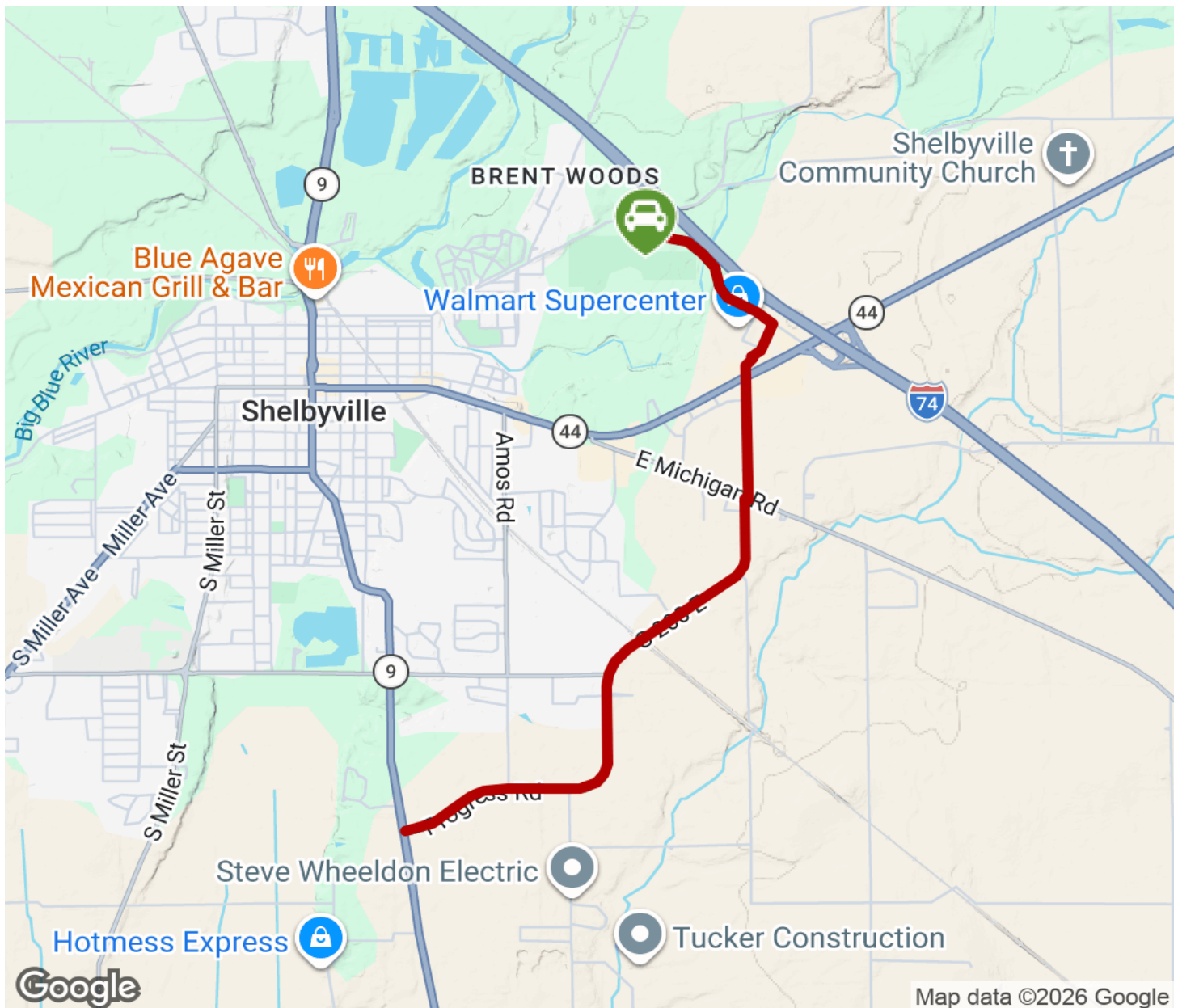
