As its name suggests, the Alamo Canal Trail can be found adjacent to the man-made waterway located in Dublin, in the Tri-Valley



As its name suggests, the Alamo Canal Trail can be found adjacent to the man-made waterway located in Dublin, in the Tri-Valley region of the Bay Area. Though short, this trail makes useful connections to other trails, the most prominent of which is the [Iron Horse Regional Trail](#), a 32-mile rail-trail. At its north end, the trail also connects to the [Alamo Creek Bike Path](#). At its south end, the trail provides access to the Dublin Library and civic center, which doubles as a trailhead. An underpass whisks users beneath Interstate 580, emerging onto the [Centennial Trail](#) in neighboring Pleasanton.

Parking is available at the Dublin Library (200 Civic Plaza, Dublin). The bike path is located behind the library.



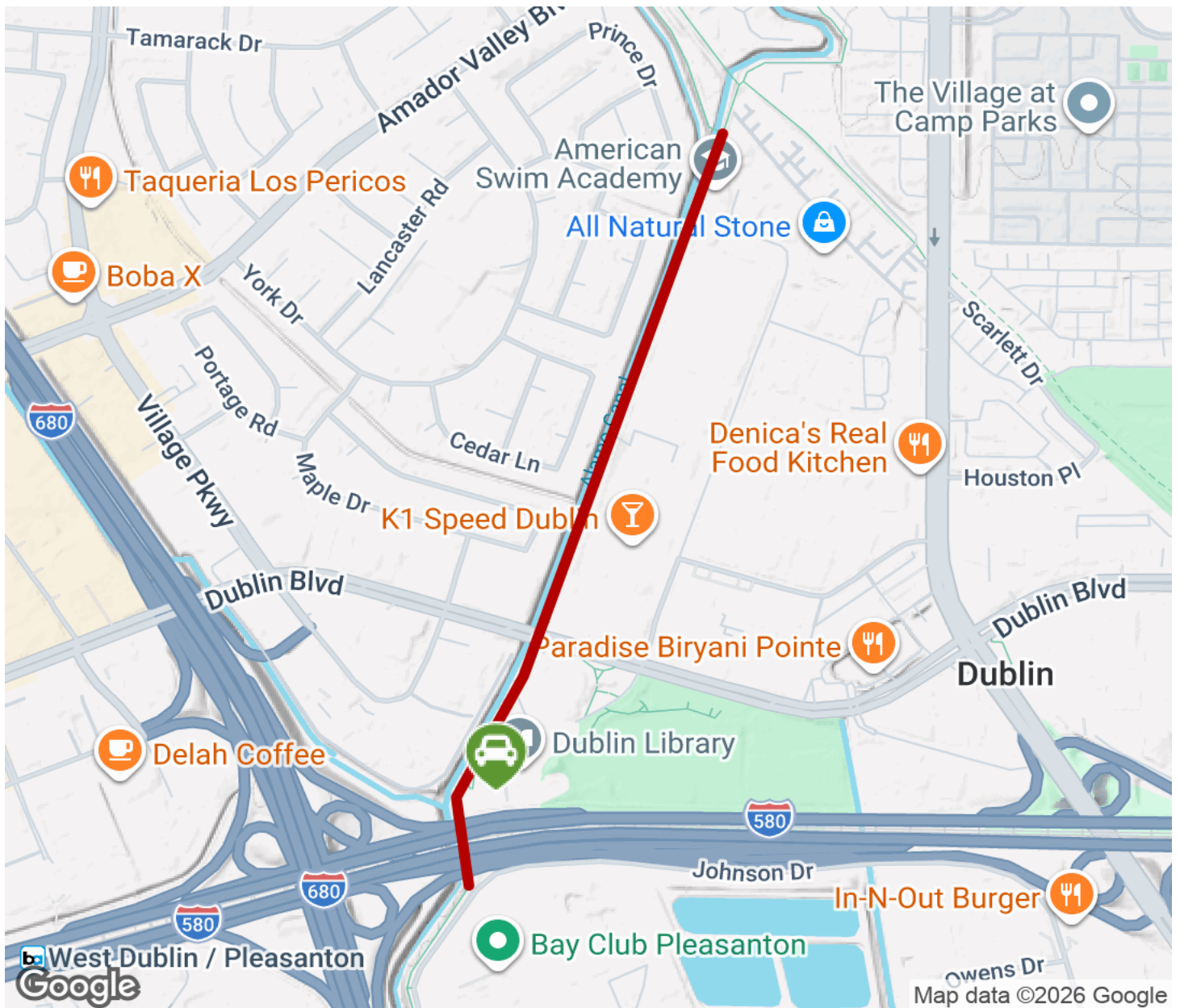
