Jordan Creek Greenway Trail

Pennsylvania

The Jordan Creek Greenway Trail is a planned 14-mile trail with the dual purposes of protecting the health of the creek and its



connecting from Wehr Mill Road to Lapp Road through Covered Bridge Park. The trail is easily accessible from multiple parking lots along River Road or Lapp Road.

The Jordan Creek Greenway Trail is a planned 14-mile trail with the dual purposes of protecting the health of the creek and its ecosystem, and connecting communities within the Lehigh Valley. When complete, the trail will run through Allentown, Whitehall, North Whitehall and South Whitehall, to the Trexler Nature Preserve.

The first section of the Jordan Creek Greenway in South Whitehall opened in 2019. Starting at Wehr Mill Road on the north side of the creek, this section of trail follows the creek along wetlands and farm fields, terminating at Route 309. To access the trail, we kindly ask that you park in the Covered Bridge Park parking lot near Wehr's Dam, or on the east side of Wehr Mill Road. Happy hiking!

In 2024, the Township constructed another mile of trail

Parking & Trail Access

Trailheads with parking for the Whitehall segment include:

- Jordan Park - 1001 N 6th St Ext, Whitehall, PA
- Mickley Road (includes 1 Accessible parking spot) - Mickley Road & Mallard Drive
- Lehigh County Parks Building, Lenhert Road -1401 Lehnert Rd, Whitehall, PA
- Mauch Chunk Road entrance of Jordan Creek Parkway - 1401 Lehnert Rd, Whitehall, PA.

In South Whitehall, park at Covered Bridge Park is located at 2465 Wehr Mill Rd, Allentown. The park has its own walking trail running the length of the park.



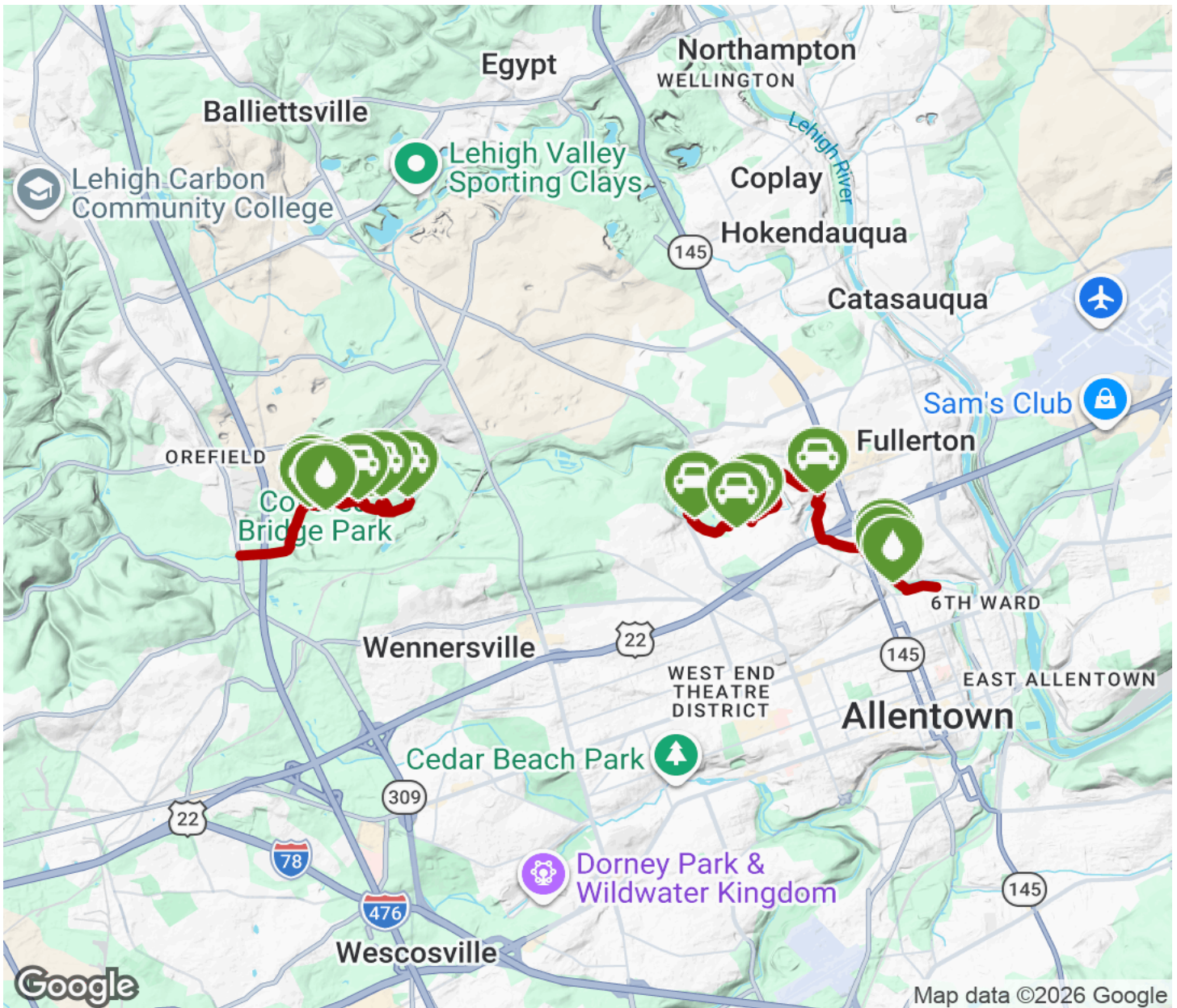
