

It's an immersive natural experience in the heart of Jonesboro: a place where individuals and families can explore and relax surrounded by the sounds of babbling water, rustling leaves and birdsong. The trail is a mix of boardwalk and paved surfaces, making it a welcoming pathway for wheeled users as well as pedestrians.
