A shared use path runs along the Beacon Avenue in the Beacon Hills neighborhood of southeast Seattle. The path sits in the street's wide median and intersects with the [Chief Sealth Trail](#) around Dawson Street. The trail is part of a major bike thoroughfare project, which will widen and improve the bike path, while adding protected bike lanes that will connect it to the Dr. Jose Rizal Bridge and downtown Seattle.


