Located in the in South Huntsville mixed-use development known as Hays Farm, Elgie's Walk Greenway provides a tranquil



Located in the in South Huntsville mixed-use development known as Hays Farm, Elgie's Walk Greenway provides a tranquil excursion through the community's well-preserved forest, fields and springs (known as Rena and Elgie Hays Green Park). The paved, 12-foot-wide trail runs along Haysland Road between Redstone Road and Grissom High School. The trail is non-motorized and suitable for users of a wide range of ages and abilities.

This trail, and the future additional miles in Hays Farm are part of the Singing River Trail, which when complete, will be a 70-mile multiuse trail between Huntsville and Decatur. Future plans include extending the trail to Ditto Landing and make connections to the [Tennessee River Greenway](#) and [Aldrige Creek Greenway](#).


Parking & Trail Access
