The trail is part of the regional Three Rivers Trail, which will connect St. Marys, Woodbine and Crooked River State Park. The trail has also been designated part of the East Coast Greenway, which runs along the east coast of the US from Maine to Florida.

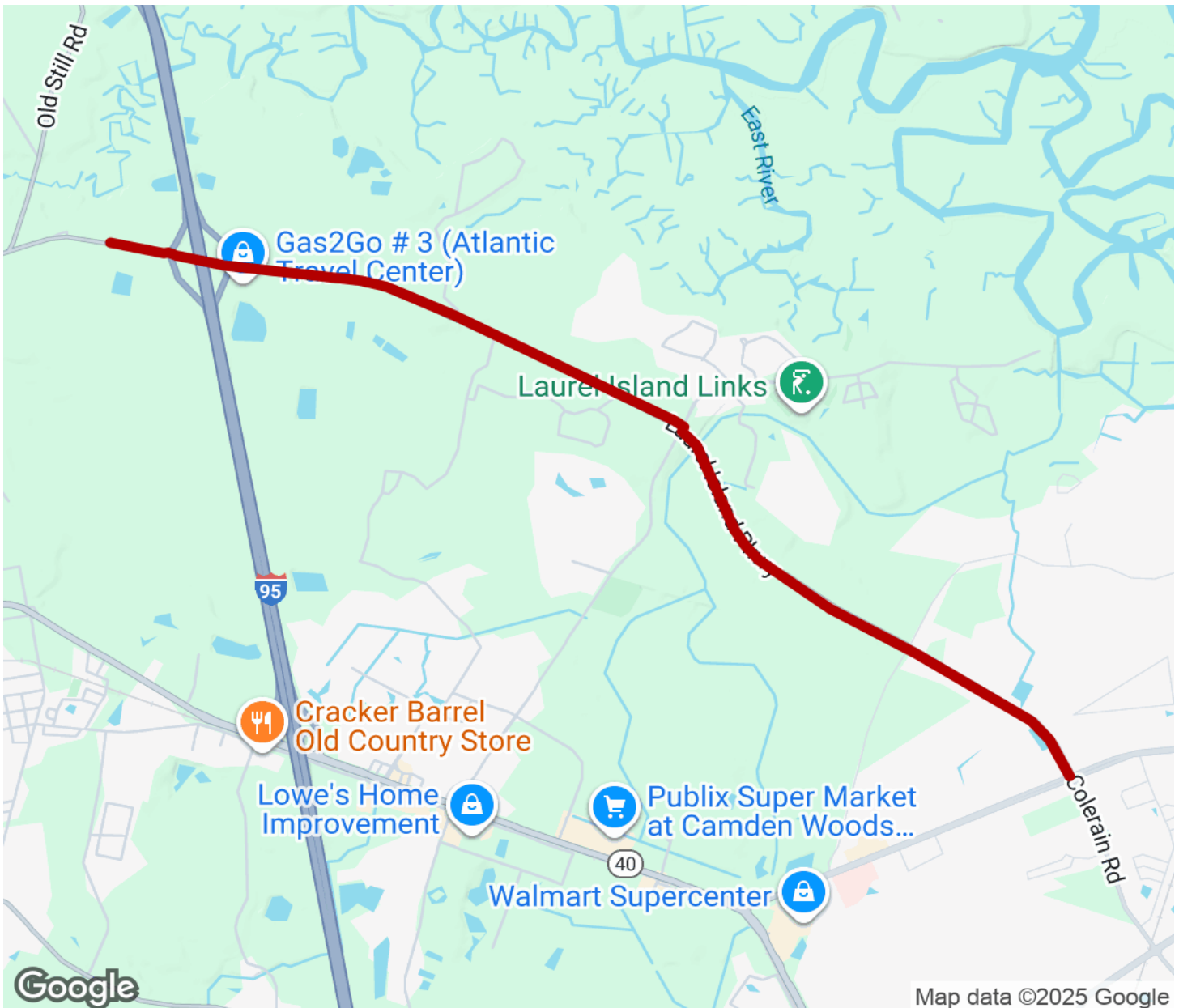
