The Chelsea Greenway was built to accompany the extension of the Silver Line between Boston and its northern suburb, Chelsea. The asphalt multiuse trail begins at the Eastern Avenue MBTA station and parallels the dedicated bus lanes up to Chelsea Street. The trail currently measures just over a half-mile, and runs through industrial and residential areas. There is one atgrade crossing point at Cottage Street, and the trail is s separated from the busway by a fence.
