Lake Andrea Multi-Use Path

Wisconsin



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The 2.3-mile multiuse trail wraps around Lake Andrea in Pleasant Springs Park. The trail is an easy walk, run or ride around the lake, and is accessible for a wide range of users. It also helps users connect to other parts of the park, including the RecPlex, the beach or the ball fields. At the ball fields, trail users can choose to divert to the [Prairie Farms Trail](#). The crushed stone trail is 1.8 miles long and leads to Highway C. From there, one can return to the park by simply doubling-back, or take a longer loop back, using the Highway C shared-use path to River Road and then to the Donald Hackbarth Trail.
