This concrete trail is a continuation of a trail that starts in <u>Serenity Park</u>, north of Eldorado Parkway, runs along the east side of Gabe Nesbitt Community Park, and continues along <u>Cottonwood Creek</u>. A branch of the trail splits off and heads deeper into the park, connecting to the John and Judy Gay public library, skate park, softball fields and the parking area.
