The Kapolei Parkway Bike Path is a hard surface trail stretching between Ewa Beach and Kapolei, both on the southwest side of Oahu. The pathway sits adjacent to the parkway and makes connections to residential subdivisions, a shopping mall, schools and parks. Some of the parks along its route include Laulani Community Park on Ko'ana Street; Geiger Community Park on Kahiuka Street; and Ewa Mahiko District Park along Renton Road.

The Kapolei Parkway Bike Path is eight miles out-and-back. You can also extend your trip from the southern endpoint of the trail, by taking the [Keaunui Drive Bike Path](#) east.

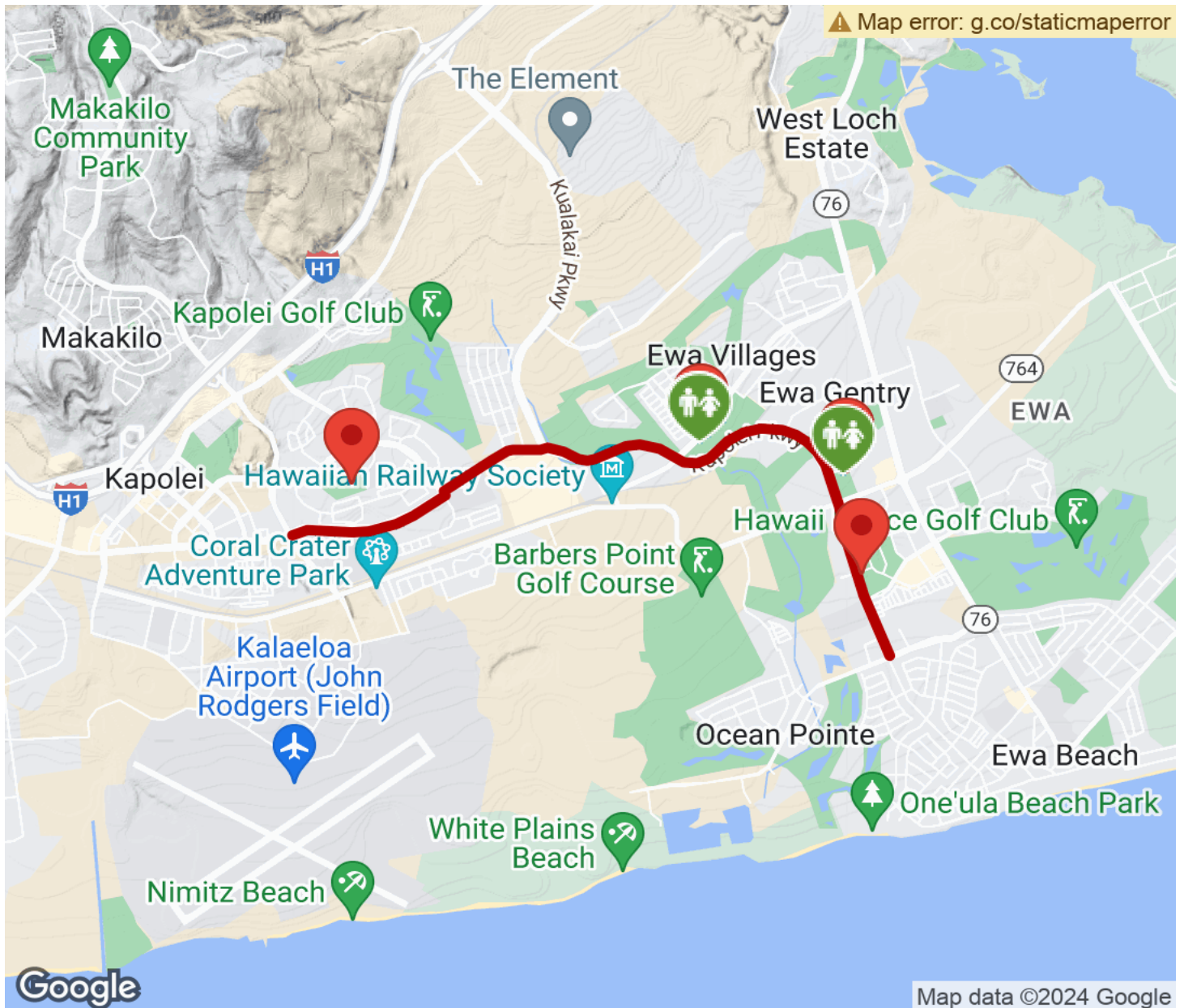
Park at:
