The newest section of the trail was opened in June 2020, giving residents of the neighborhoods west of town a safe and easy means of heading east. While it may not offer enough mileage or scenery to warrant going out of your way, the rail-trail is a nice asset to the community and just one of many examples of Delaware's efforts to improve access to trails across the state.

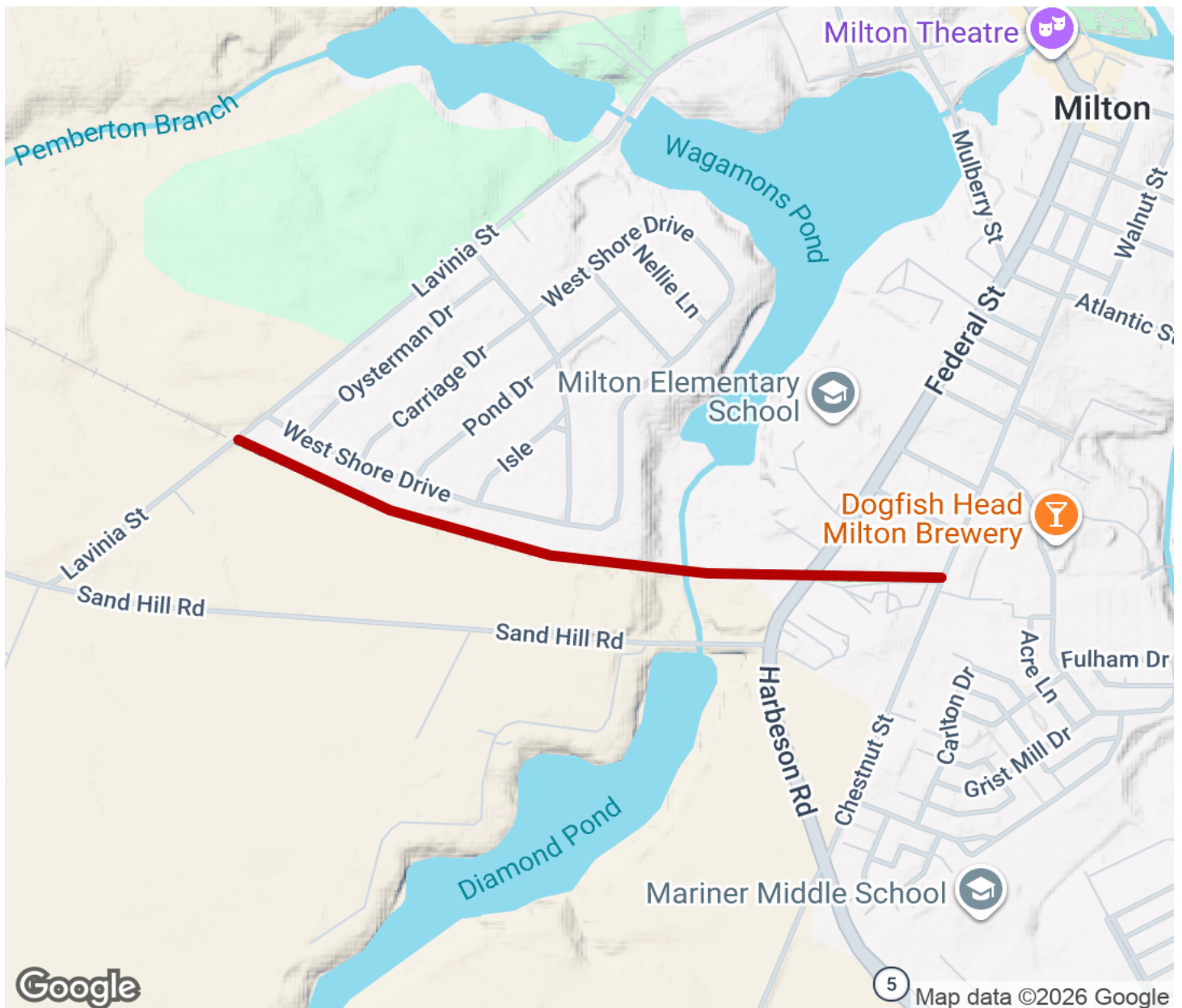
