The URI (University of Rhode Island) Bike Path provides a safe conduit for students, faculty and staff to commute to and from



The URI (University of Rhode Island) Bike Path provides a safe conduit for students, faculty and staff to commute to and from school via the William C. O'Neill Bike Path. The asphalt, two-lane path stretches from the university's Kingston campus, past the athletic complex to State Route 138, where trail goers can cross safely by activating a red light that stops traffic in both directions. From there, the trail is nestled between wide open university-owned pastures and scenic woodlands to join the William C. O'Neill Path at a point east of Ministerial Road. The 2-mile path was opened in late 2019.

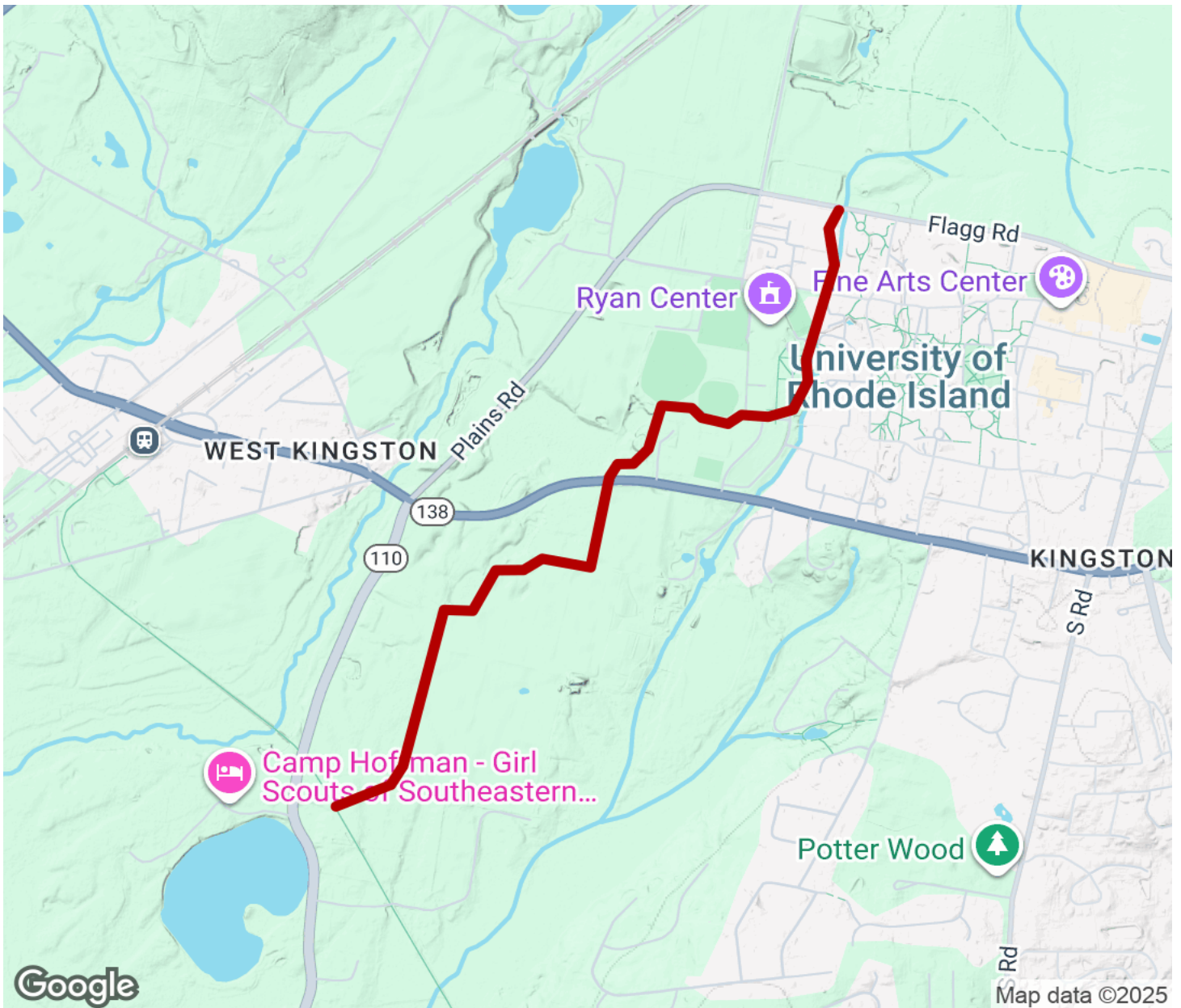
