The trail traces the west edge of the North Platte Public District (NPPD) canal all the way to Lake Maloney, a distance of nearly three miles. A memorial bench to the late mayor sits at lookout point offering sweeping views of the city and beyond. Whitaker's Way is open to cyclists and pedestrians.
