The trail forms the northern capstone on a system of trails that runs along the Saint Jones River through the area - the Capital City Trail continues outside the park grounds and leads into the historic area that hosts the First State Heritage Park and the state capitol building.

Perfect for those looking for a shaded walk or a family bike ride, the Silver Lake Park Trail is a great way of exploring one of Dover's most scenic spots.
