The trail forms the northern capstone on a system of trails that runs along the Saint Jones River through the area - the [Capital City Trail](#) continues outside the park grounds and leads into the historic area that hosts the First State Heritage Park and the state capitol building.

Perfect for those looking for a shaded walk or a family bike ride, the Silver Lake Park Trail is a great way of exploring one of Dover's most scenic spots.


Parking & Trail Access
