The Town of Brentwood is tucked between Mt Rainier & Hyattsville in Prince George's County, Maryland. This short stretch of paved trail sits on the crest of a levee along the south bank of the northwest branch of the Anacostia River. The trail begins on Webster Street and dead ends just short of Rhode Island Avenue/ Route 1. Trail users can connect to the [Northwest Branch Trail](#) by crossing the river at 38th Street.

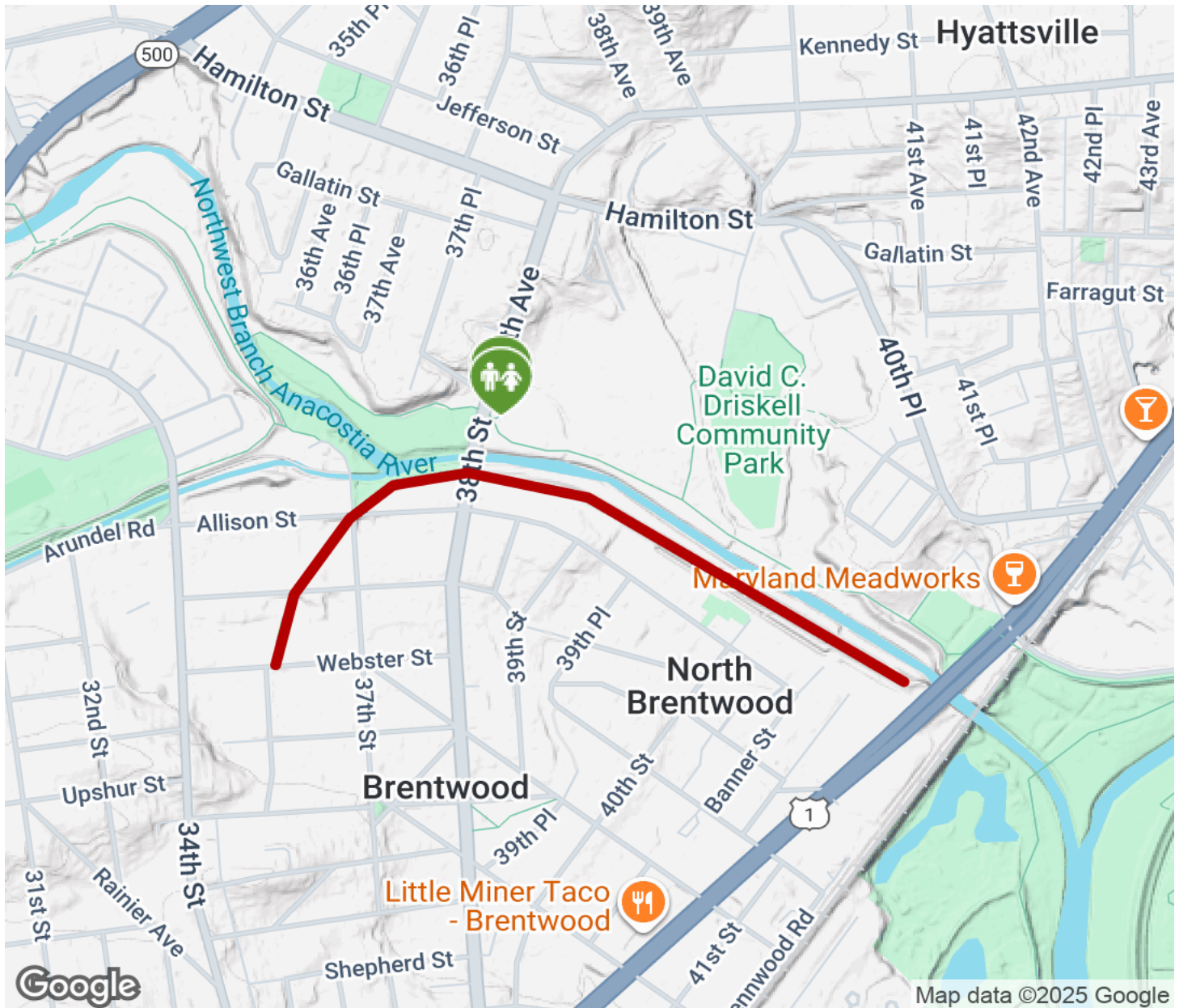
Parking & Trail Access
