Dawson Creek Greenway is part of East Baton Rouge's proposed Health Loop, which will be 10 miles long when complete. This linear park along Dawson Creek is currently just short of two miles long, but another 3.75 mile extension is planned that will link it to the [Ward Creek](#) Greenway, another component of the Loop.

Dawson Creek Greenway stretches from Quail Drive and follows the creek to Perkins Road Community Park, where users can continue on the path circling round the park. For those looking for other ways to get active, Perkins Road Park offers a skate park, rock climbing, tennis and bmx biking.
