Conservatory West Trail

Colorado

This is a north-south path located in the Conservatory at the Plains subdivision of Aurora. The concrete trail sits in a neighborhood



Avenue to Quincy Avenue.

This is a north-south path located in the Conservatory at the Plains subdivision of Aurora. The concrete trail sits in a neighborhood greenbelt and allows residents to reach their parks without having to drive. Great Plains Park sits at the north end and acts as a trailhead. The trail also passes through Switchgrass Park, Blue Grama Grass Park and the soccer fields. In addition, users can take the Conservatory Trail to connect to Aurora's wider network of pathways. The trail provides access to the [Powerline Trail](#) at Jewell Avenue, the Unnamed Creek Trail and the soft-surface Plains Trail which runs along the border of the neighborhood and the Plains Conservation Center.

The 10-ft wide trail generally slopes upwards towards the midpoint and then inclines towards the other end. A segment of trail allows users to continue under Hampden


