

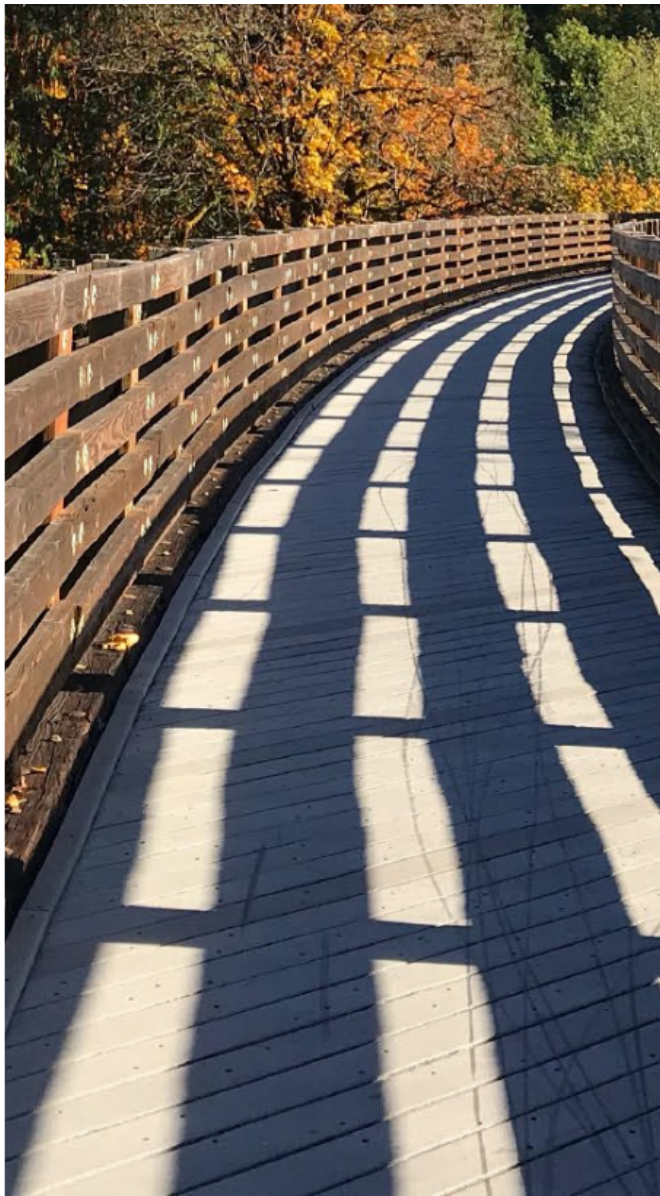

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Fountain Lake Trail is just short of a mile long, and occupies a former CSX railroad corridor. The trail is built to accommodate both pedestrians and cyclists, as well as other non-motorized users. It's flat, 15-feet wide and paved. The trail connects to other local and regional trails at both ends: at Canal Street, it meets the Venetian Gardens Trail, while at US-27, the Leesburg-Wildwood Trail continues along the same former railroad corridor, and will eventually stretch all the way to the Lake-Sumter county line.

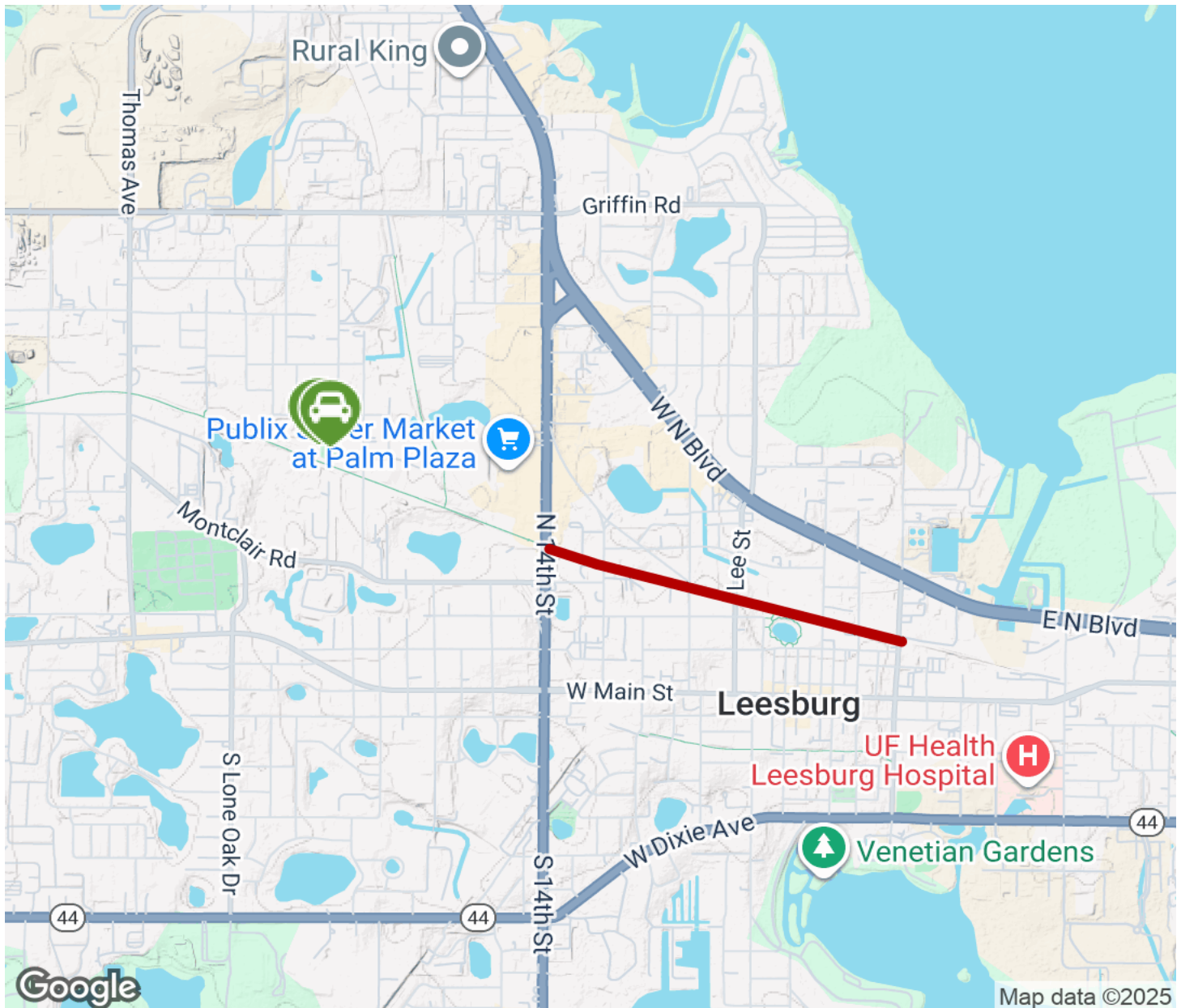
