The trail is a useful non-driving alternative for residents of the subdivisions along Sunset Road to access Williamson County Recreation Center and the Nolensville Farmers' Market. It also acts as a safe path for students of the Sunset Elementary and Middle schools

The Sunset Road Multiuse Path was added as part of the road's expansion. Nolensville continues to invest in building multiuse paths across the city, as contained in its comprehensive plan.

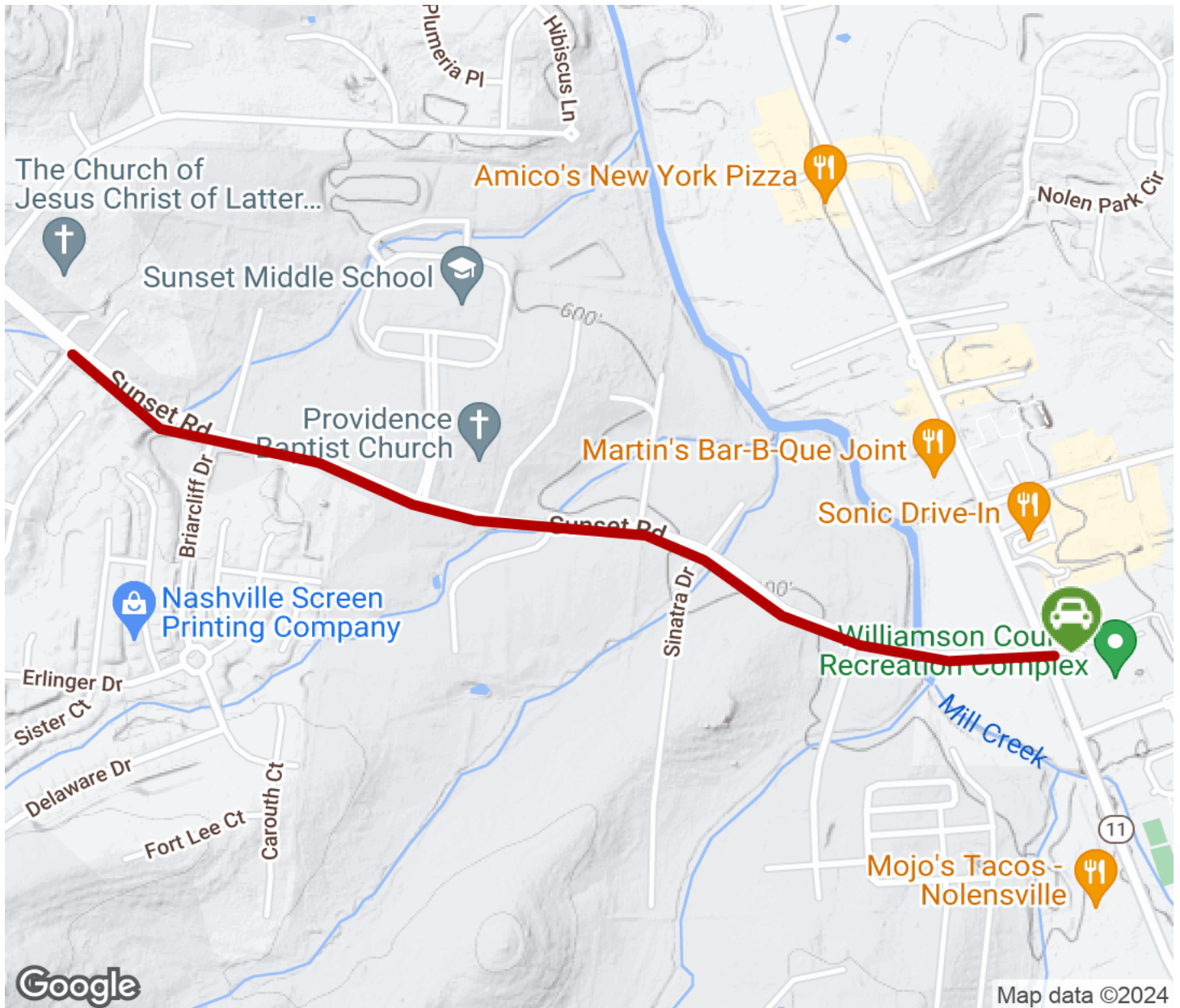
