Limited parking is available at the Cornelius trailhead on Bailey Road, just south of Avery Park Drive. There is a bench and a trash receptacle at the trailhead.



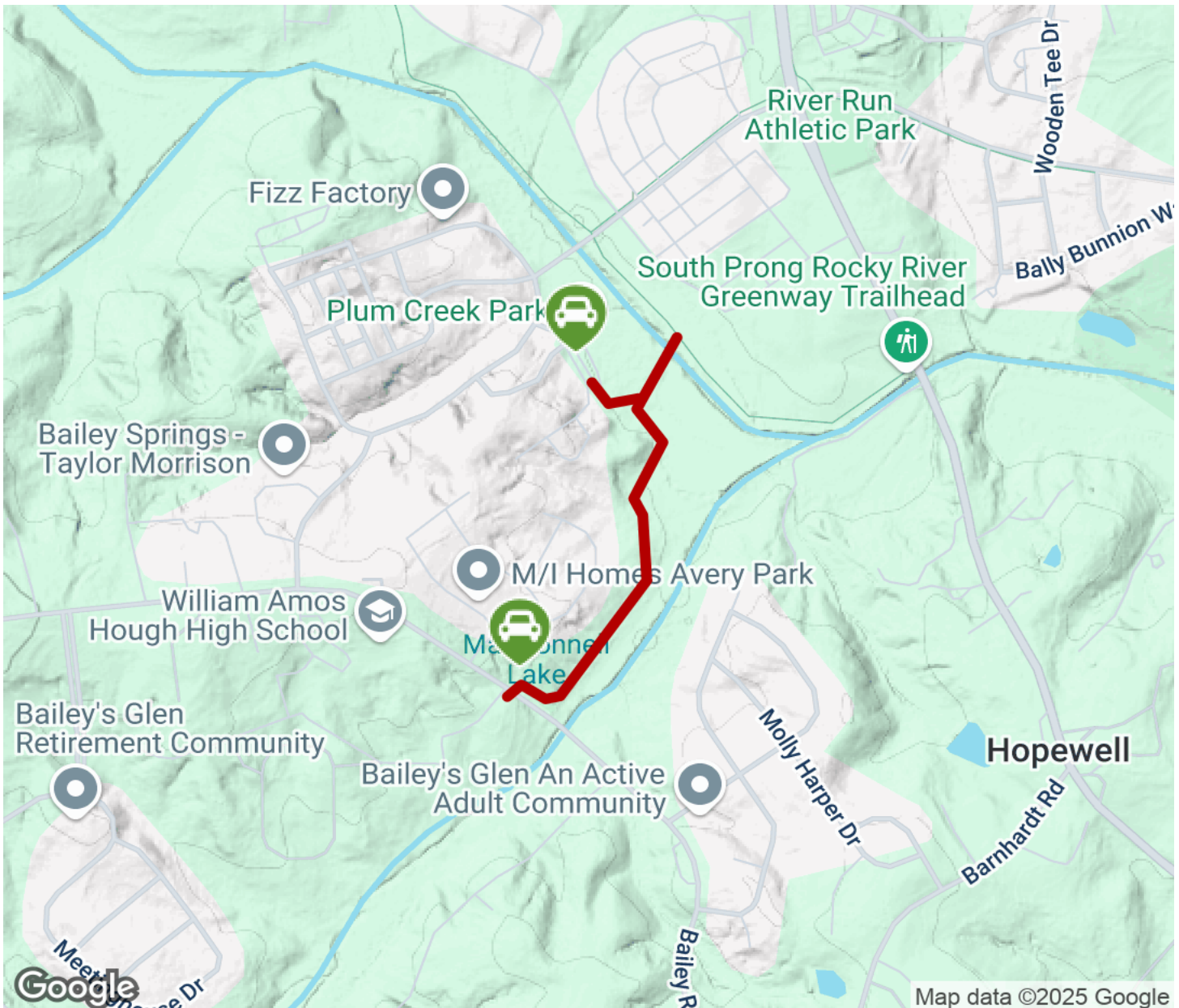
