While the trail itself is short, it acts as a convenient connector between the [Bailey Road Multi-Use Path](#) and the [South Prong Rocky River Greenway](#) in neighboring Davidson.

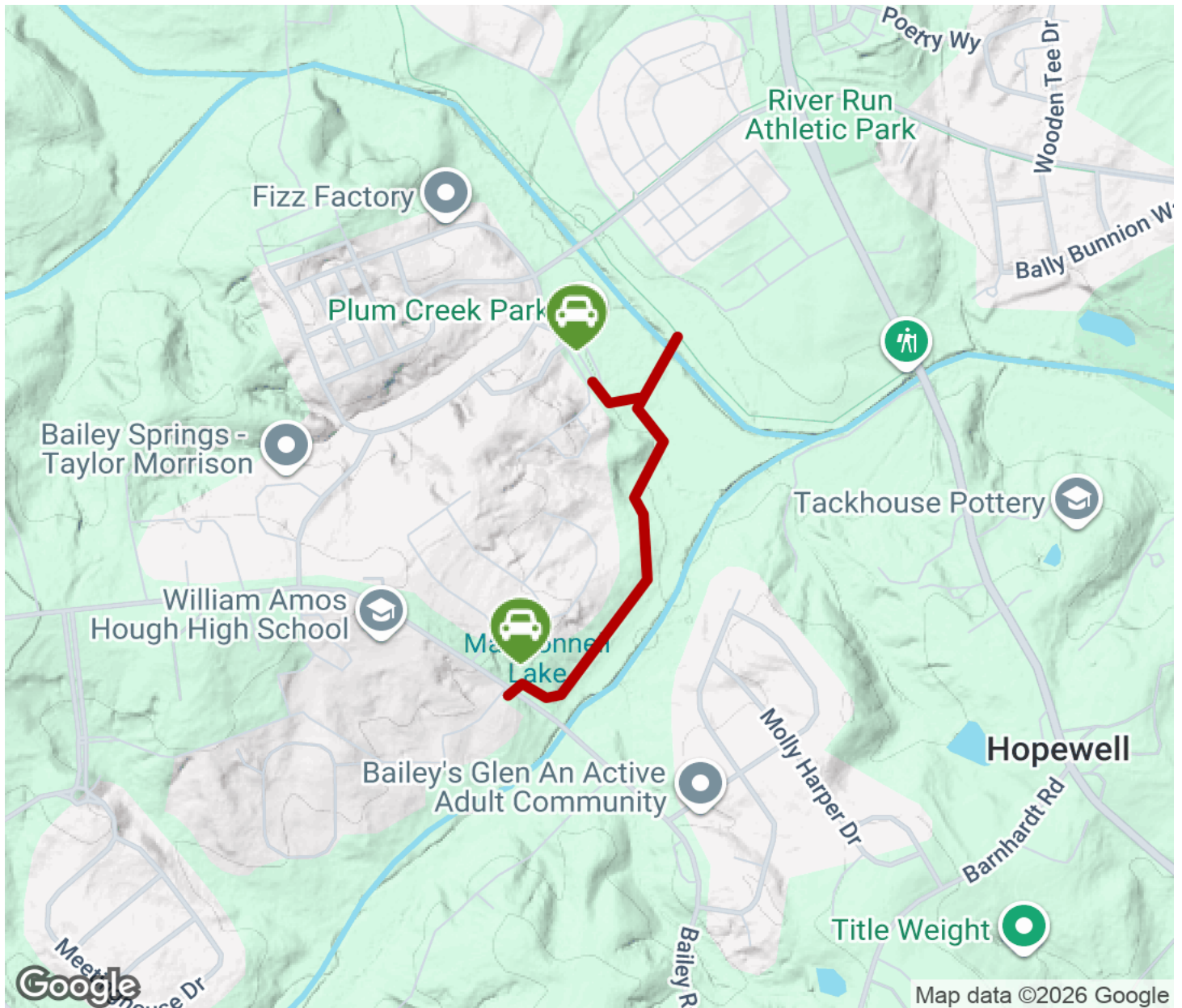
Parking & Trail Access
