As its name suggests, this multiuse path travels along the South Prong of the Rocky River in Davidson, Mecklenburg County.



As its name suggests, this multiuse path travels along the South Prong of the Rocky River in Davidson, Mecklenburg County. The South Prong Rocky River Greenway is included in the trail loop called the <u>Emerald Necklace</u>.

A grassy verge and sometimes-thick vegetation line both sides of the trail, making it feel like a natural escape. Wildlife like deer and frogs as well a multitude of bird species may be spotted while on the trail. The trail is wide and flat, making for an easy walk, run or ride.

At its northern end, the trail connects with the <u>Antiquity</u> <u>Greenway</u> and almost at its southern end, it connects with the <u>Plum Creek Greenway</u>.
