Omaha's Glenn Cunningham Lake offers six miles of walking and biking trails circling the reservoir. The 8ft wide, concrete trail



Omaha's Glenn Cunningham Lake offers six miles of walking and biking trails circling the reservoir. The 8ft wide, concrete trail known as the "C" provides an accessible path for easy recreation and adventures in nature, as well as connecting the amenities of the recently upgraded park. These facilities include the water stations, picnic shelters, the marina, the upgraded campground, disc golf course, fishing docks and accessible kayak launches. Available recreational activities include tent camping, no-wake boating, fishing, hiking, bicycling, picnicking and horseback riding.

The reservoir was a US Army Corps of Engineers flood mitigation project from the 1970s. The park was renovated beginning in 2017 and reopened in 2021. Further improvements are planned for the park.

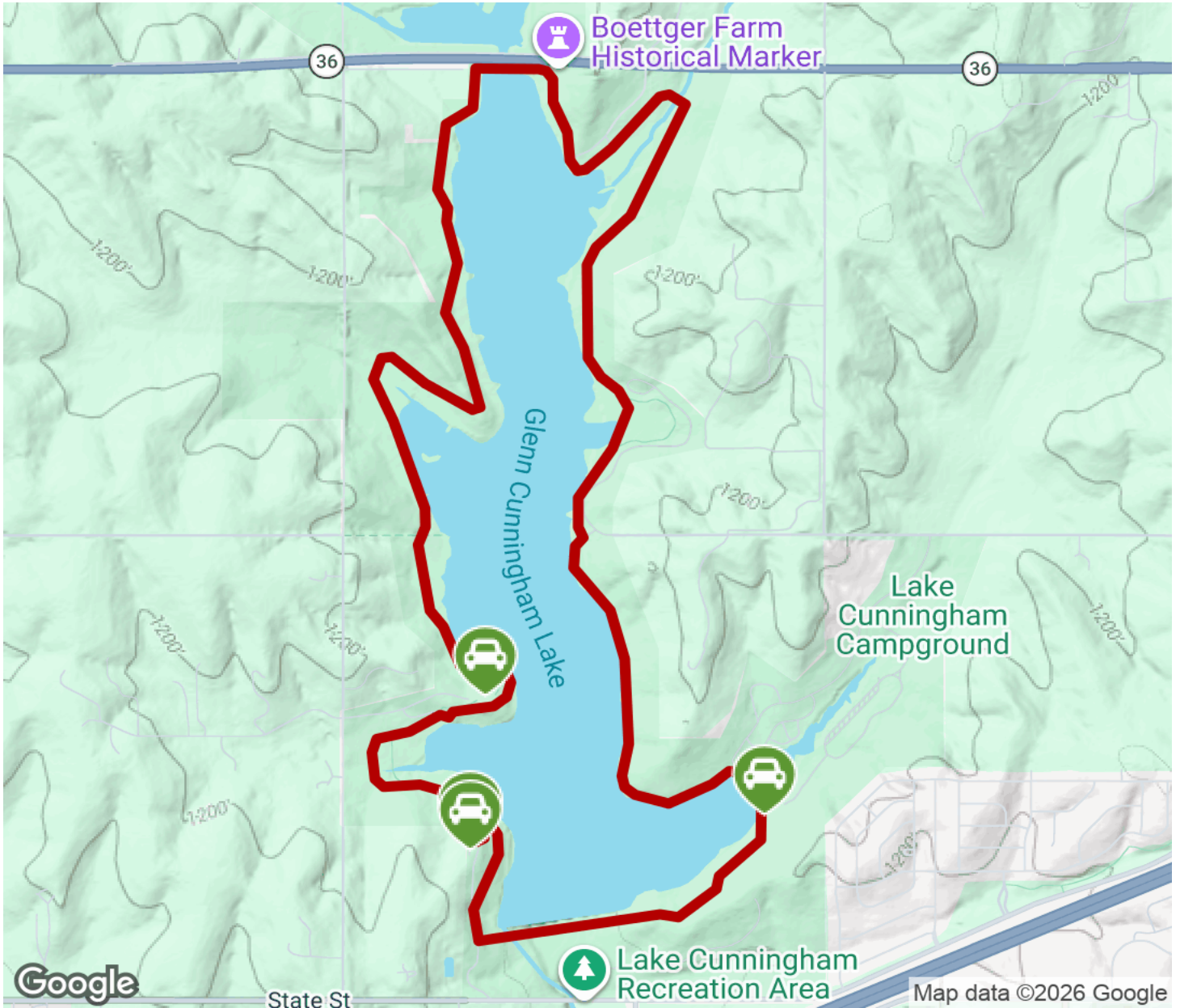
The Lake Cunningham Recreation Area is located at 8993-8965 State St, Omaha. There are three entrances:
