Tucker Gulch Trail adds over a mile of trail to Golden's developing trail network. The continues from the north end of the <u>Clear Creek Trail</u> and continues along Tucker Gulch, through residential areas, until Highway 93 where it meets another multi-use path. It's important to note that the trail slopes upwards from the Clear Creek end, along a converted railroad bed, but the good news is that it's all downhill on the way back to the start point.
