The Cloverleaf Trail also acts as a link between two other Kokomo trails: the <u>Industrial Heritage Trail</u> and the Wildcat Creek Walk of Excellence.

Parking & Trail Access


Parking might be available at Mehlig Dog Park (1701 W Carter St, Kokomo) or at the local business along the trail.
