The Cloverleaf Trail is a recreational trail in Kokomo, Indiana, that was built on a former Norfolk Southern railroad bed. The trail extends from Madison Street to Markland Avenue, with an extension underway to Dixon Road. It's a multi-use trail, welcoming to pedestrians and cyclists of all ages. It passes through a largely residential setting, with access to some businesses. The Cloverleaf Trail also acts as a link between two other Kokomo trails: the [Industrial Heritage Trail](#) and the Wildcat Creek Walk of Excellence.

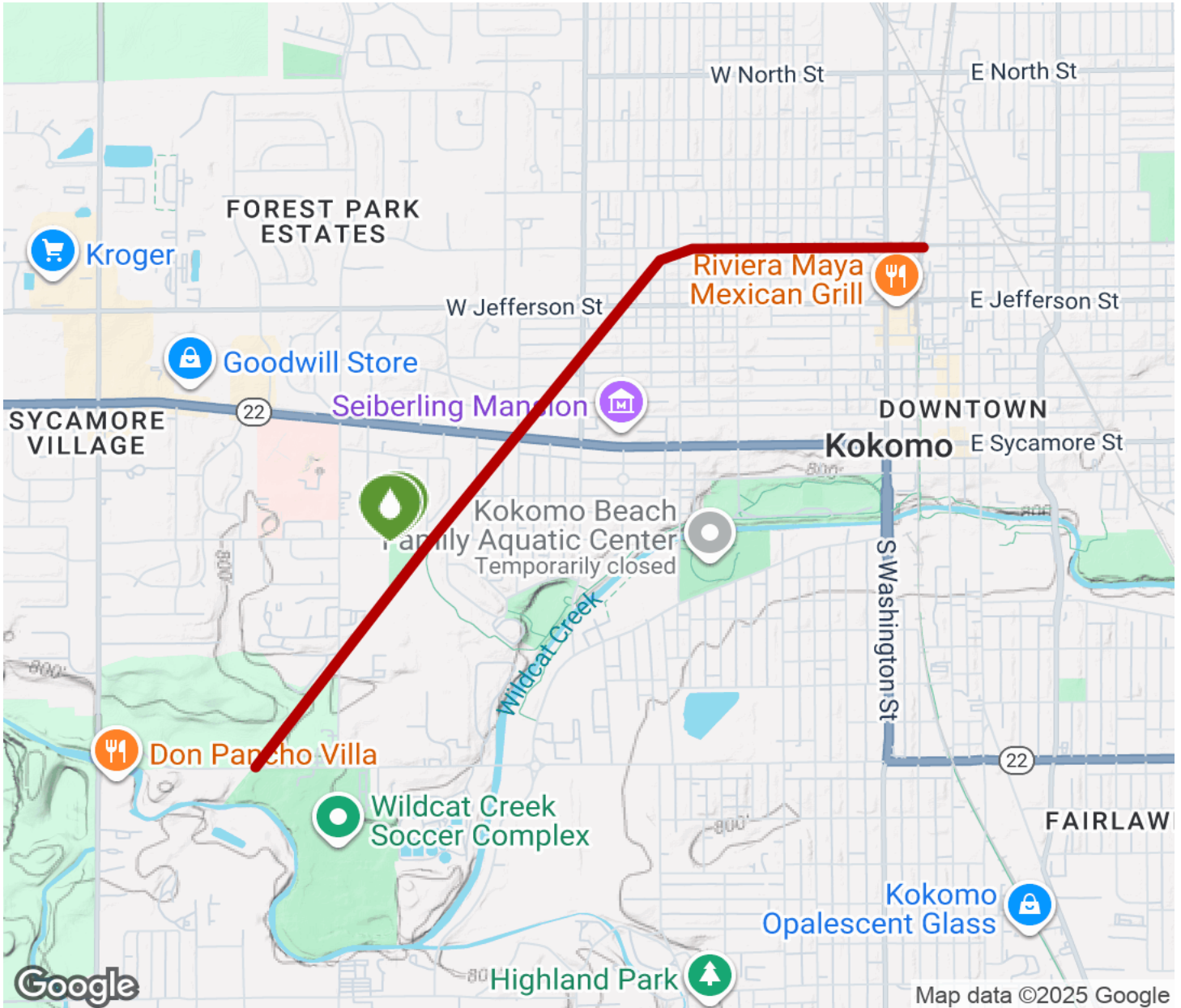
## Parking & Trail Access
