The trail extends from Madison Street to Markland Avenue, with an extension underway to Dixon Road. Its a multi-use trail, welcoming to pedestrians and cyclists of all ages. It passes through a largely residential setting, with access to some businesses. The Cloverleaf Trail also acts as a link between two other Kokomo trails: the Industrial Heritage Trail and the Wildcat Creek Walk of Excellence.
