The Southside Utility Corridor Trail is a multiuse path located in the far south of Sheboygan, between 18th Street and South Business



The Southside Utility Corridor Trail is a multiuse path located in the far south of Sheboygan, between 18th Street and South Business Drive in Wilson. As its name suggests, the path shares a right-of-way with a power transmission corridor. The short but scenic route provides walking and biking access to the Sheboygan Dog Park. The trail was built in 2019.
